On April 3, 2024 at about 0930 hours, I, Deputy S. Washington was dispatched to 20400 Colonel Glenn Road (Colonel Glenn Youth Home) in reference to a battery.

Upon my arrival, I was advised by communications that the complainant later identified as was not present at Colonel Glenn Youth Home, he was at the Sheriff's Office and wanted a Deputy to take photographs of his daughter (who was currently at the youth home). Per communications, the complainant advised them that his daughter was assaulted by another young lady yesterday (April 2). I made multiple attempts to make contact with the complainant via phone but was unsuccessful.

on her body, she did not fall to the ground, and there were no obvious bruises on her.				


