Primary Narrative By Sean Washington, 04/03/24 11:53

Battery

On April 3, 2024 at about 0930 hours, I, Deputy S. Washington was dispatched to 20400 Colonel Glenn Road (Colonel Glenn Youth Home) in reference to a battery.

Upon my arrival, I was advised by communications that the complainant later identified as [REDACTED] was not present at Colonel Glenn Youth Home, he was at the Sheriff's Office and wanted a Deputy to take photographs of his daughter (who was currently at the youth home). Per communications, the complainant advised them that his daughter was assaulted by another young lady yesterday (April 2). I made multiple attempts to make contact with the complainant via phone but was unsuccessful.

While still on the scene at the Youth Home I made contact with the victim, [REDACTED] stated that a girl only identified as [REDACTED] struck her twice in the back of the head with a closed fist, leaving her with a knot. According to [REDACTED] the incident took place yesterday afternoon at approximately 1615 hours. [REDACTED] was involved in a confrontation with someone else, and as she walked past [REDACTED] she punched her twice in the back of the head unprovoked. After she was punched [REDACTED] just walked away. This incident occurred in the presence of staff members Ms. Kierra and Mr. Michael. [REDACTED] stated that the incident left her with pain in the back of her head and feeling a little dizzy. [REDACTED] stated she was still feeling dizzy and still having pain to the back of her head. MEMS was not contacted at the time of the incident, and she was still refusing medical attention. [REDACTED] advised me that she did not feel any pain any where else on her body, she did not fall to the ground, and there were no obvious bruises on her.

I then spoke briefly with a staff member who advised me that Ms. Kierra Taylor and Mr. Michael (unknown last name) would be at work at approximately 1500 hours.

On April 3, 2024 at about 1143 hours, I, Deputy S. Washington was advised [REDACTED] wanted phone contact

in reference to his daughter being assaulted at the Colonel Glenn Youth Home.

I made contact with [REDACTED] via phone. [REDACTED] advised me that someone with the Sheriff's Office advised him that an arrest had made regarding his daughter's previous assault. I advised [REDACTED] that to my knowledge no arrest was made. [REDACTED] advised me that his daughter, [REDACTED] called him yesterday evening and told him she was struck twice in the head by another young lady. Due to [REDACTED] being on probations, she did not fight back and he wished to pursue charges.

[REDACTED] was given an incident number and information on how to pursue charges.

Battery

On April 4, 2024 at about 1633 hours, I, Deputy S. Washington arrived at 20400 Colonel Glenn Road in reference to a follow up.

Upon my arrival, I spoke with someone in the office and was able to gather further information about the battery that occurred on April 2, 2024.

I was advised that the offender was named [REDACTED] and the Clinic Director is named Peggy Kelley. Information was added to this report due to the victims father wishing to pursue charges.
