Narrative & Statements

Narrative - Morris, Justin Lee - 4/6/2024 9:53:26 AM (Initial)

On April 6, 2024 at approximately 9:00 am I, Officer Morris, was dispatched to Methodist Family Health, 211 Church St, in reference to an 11 year old male client creating a disturbance. On arrival, I made contact with Kyle Williams, a worker at Methodist Family Health. Kyle advised that Juvenile 1 has been fighting and running on tables and generally not listening to the staff. He advised that he needed someone to speak with Juvenile 1 and explain to him that there is consequences to his actions.

I made contact with Juvenile 1. He was sitting at a table in the "day room". I explained to him that fighting can lead to him being arrested and spoke with him about options he should consider before breaking the rules of the facility. He agreed that he would calm down and obey the staff at the facility.

Kyle advised that they did not wish to pursue charges.



Under the Arkansas Penal Code 5-54-122, Filing a False Report with Law Enforcement Agency:

- (A) For the purpose of this section, "Report" means any communications, written or oral, sworn or un-sworn.
- (B) A person commits the offense of filing a false report with any Law Enforcement agency or prosecuting attorneys of any alleged criminal wrongdoing on the part of another knowing that such a report is false.
- (C) (1) Filing a false report is a class D Felony if:
 - (a) The crime is a capital offense, Class Y Felony, Class A Felony, Class B Felony; or
 - (b) The agency or office to whom the report is made has expended in excess of five-hundred dollars (\$500) in order to investigate said report, including the cost of labor; or
 - (c) Physical injury results to any person as a result of the false report; or
 - (d) The false report is made in an effort by the person filing the false report to conceal his own criminal activity; or
 - (e) The false report results in another person being arrested.

(2) Otherwise, filing a false report is a Class A Misdemeanor.


