Description:

On Thursday April 11, 2024 at approximately 21:03 hours I (Wills) was dispatched to a battery report at Perimeter of the Ozarks located at 2466 S 48th St. Dispatch advised that there was an employee that wanted to make a report about an incident.

When I arrived I made contact with a female later identified as Mia Velasquez (H/F DOB: [REDACTED].) I asked Mia to tell me what happened. Mia stated that she was watching over the patient and one of them got a towel. The patient then started wrapping it around her neck in an attempt to harm herself. Mia said that along with a couple other employees they tried to get the towel away from the patient. While getting the towel the patient punched and kicked her in the face. Mia was able to get the towel away from patient and restrained her. While the patient was restrained, she kicked Mia again causing her to stumble backwards and heard a pop in her upper neck.

I asked Mia if she wanted to press charges and she said yes. I then asked if she wanted an ambulance to check her out and she said yes. I radioed dispatch and requested an ambulance for her. While they were responding I began gathering Mia's information for the report. The ambulance arrived and Mia decided to go to the hospital. Another officer followed Mia to the hospital while I remained on scene to get the suspects information.

I went inside the building and spoke with the manager. I asked the manager if she saw what happened and she said no. I asked if they could provide me with information for the patient. The manager said yes and printed a copy of face sheet. The face sheet identified the suspect as [REDACTED] (W/F DOB: [REDACTED]) I asked the manager if there was any camera footage of the incident and she checked her computer. After searching for a few minutes she was able to find the recording.



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In the recording I observed Mia and the other staff members in the hallway. On another angle you can see a towel being whipped toward Mia. Mia was able to get ahold of it but then it loses sight of her. With another angle you can see that there is someone on the ground kicking at Mia. I asked the manager if she could provide me a copy of the footage and she said no. The manager advised that I would have to subpoena the company. I advised that would be something that could be handled at another time. I then asked the manager if there was anybody still working that witnessed the event. The manager then went further into the facility to find another worker. A male came out and said he was with Mia when the incident happened. I asked if he would provide me with a written statement and he said yes. I returned to my patrol vehicle and got a witness statement form. I asked him to fill it out while I contacted the Washington County Juvenile intake officer.

I contacted the officer and informed them of the situation. She provided me with the court date of 07/19/2024 at 1100 am at 123 N College Ave. I then contacted the name listed for [REDACTED] guardian. A female that identified herself as [REDACTED] (W/F DOB: [REDACTED]) I informed her of the situation and advised her of the court date. She had a few questions which I tried to answer. Any questions that I was not able to answer I referred her to the Washington County Sheriff's office.

The other officer returned with Mia's statement and I went inside to speak with the witness. I collected his statement and provided him with a copy of the citation. I then returned to the station to complete the report. I completed the required paperwork and turned the statements into the complete box. I do not have any more information at this time.
