Little Rock Police Department arrived at the facility with MEMS EMS. was transported to Arkansas Childrens Hospital by MEMS to be checked out due to she was complaining of neck and head pain. was shortly released from ACH and diagnosed with a concussion. is an out of state client and her guardian was notified.

Narrative:

4/17/24- Facility visited in response to peer-on-peer physical altercation. Camera footage was reviewed which showed resident assault resident in a classroom.

During the video, a classroom was observed with a ratio varying from 1:9 to 2:9 at different times. 1:9 ratio was observed for 1 minute in the classroom with the door shut. Facility cited 907.3. Ratio then increased 2:9,

and resident is seen arguing back and forth with Resident Resident is then observed standing over the table assaulting Resident One staff immediately begins to call for assistance on her radio while attempting to pull Resident away, but was unsuccessful in preventing the assault. Another staff member is observed immediately escorting the residents out of the classroom. Two additional staff and a nurse entered the classroom to separate the two residents without further incident.
