Narrative:

Incident occurred 4/12/2024 and was not entered into ELS until 4/16/2024. However, Licensing was notified via text on 4/14/2024. Moving forward, ELS notification will need to be made by the following business day.

4/18/24 – Facility visited in response to an incident involving two residents [REDACTED] horseplaying and resulting in Resident [REDACTED]'s broken wrist.

Resident [REDACTED] and Resident [REDACTED] were both interviewed separately by licensing staff. Resident [REDACTED] reported that he was horseplaying “WWE” (wrestling) with Resident [REDACTED] reported that it was not a fight and they were only playing around. [REDACTED] stated that staff was within arm’s length of them and were aware that they were wrestling. [REDACTED] stated that he felt safe at the facility but would like the staff to take horseplaying more seriously. [REDACTED] stated that once he was injured, staff took immediate action to address the injury.

[REDACTED] was then interviewed and reported that the incident was horseplay and not a fight. [REDACTED] stated that staff were also aware they were playing “WWE” and were within arm’s length. [REDACTED] also stated that he felt safe at the facility.

Staff were reportedly present and in direct supervision of incident involving residents. Staff were reportedly aware of the horseplaying game, which resulted in the injury of a resident. Facility cited 907.2. Per Jlynn Perkins of Little Creek, two trainings will be held facility-wide on 4/18/24, regarding Resident Safety/Horseplay.
