Nursing Assessment date/time: 05/08/24 12:46pm: observed sitting at the lunch table with DON, coughing and dry heaving into a box. C/o feeling as if something was still lodged in throat and need to vomit. No emesis noted. Patient continued to cough and spit into the box. A cold wet towel was placed on the back of patient's. Nearby team members reported a ball of chips was dislodged from patient's throat and spit out following Heimlich Maneuver. AAOx4. Airway appears patent as client is able to talk, cough, and breath without difficulty. No signs of respiratory distress, labored breathing, or wheezing. No signs of nasal flaring. No signs of pallor or cyanosis. Patient continued to cough and spit into box. Attending MD notified with order to transport client to ACH ER to rule out injuries to esophagus, further obstruction, or aspiration. Patient was able to ambulate to the van without difficulty. Instructed to avoid eating or drinking anything until evaluation. Guardian was notified on 05/08/24 at 1:14pm and 5:00pm Guardian was called and notified via voicemail that client was being transported to ACH ER to rule out injuries, obstructions, or aspiration following choking that required the Heimlich maneuver. Patient returned from ACH ER with Can use Maalox or other heartburn meds for pain control if needed. Maalox administered to ACH ER at 1505. Guardian called and notified of patient returning to
