## Primary Narrative By Lance Parker, 05/13/24 23:54

### Disturbance

On 5/13/2024 at approximately 1804 hours Deputy Bass and I, Deputy L. Parker, were dispatched to the youth home located at 20400 Colonel Glenn Road in Little Rock, AR for a disturbance. We were informed prior to arrival that one of the clients was threatening staff members and acting in an aggressive manner after hearing the news that would be getting transported to another facility for acute care; they further advised that they had restrained

Upon arrival, Deputies made contact with the caller, Sebrina Patton, who advised that had since calmed down and they had unrestrained. Patton advised that there was no physical altercation that took place. She advised that was upset about having to move to a different facility and lashed out in the form of threats, aggressive behavior and causing minor damage to a restroom; none of which are actions that Patton wished to pursue charges for. Patton provided Deputies with a copy of face sheet and we stood by for security while MEMS arrived on scene to transport. Patton was provided a copy of the report number and advised to call the Sheriff's Office if they needed any further assistance.
