Report Description: On 05.26.24, at 1850, Resident [REDACTED] [REDACTED] [REDACTED] [REDACTED] asked to take a shower right before med pass time. While, in the shower, [REDACTED] responded to all calls from the staff who were checking in on the resident. During med pass on a separate unit, a code was called. The staff called for [REDACTED] again, and she answered the staff. After, the third call to get the resident out of the shower, [REDACTED] did not answer. [REDACTED] was found unresponsive on the floor upon staff entering the bathroom. [REDACTED] had a sliver small blade and lying beside her with cuts to her left and right thigh. The nursing staff entered the unit when the code blue was called grabbed vitals, and called for the EMT and Director of Nursing. The Director of Nursing arrived at the unit and did a sternum rub, and she popped up. She was transported to the Emergency Department with superficial cuts to rule out anything further. She returned to Little Creek at 2118.

Interim Action Narrative: Resident was assessed by the nurse and sent to the ER for further evaluation. Resident placed on close observation and clinical restrictions.

Maltreatment Narrative:

Licensing Narrative: Program Coordinator reviewed provider reported incident for licensing concerns. Program Coordinator inquired about incident and requested

documentation. Resident was placed on close observation and clinical restrictions. While on another visit, Program Coordinator requested nursing notes. Facility reported that resident got the small blade from a pencil sharpener out of a classroom. Per facility, hand held pencil sharpeners have been confiscated and will no longer be utilized in the classrooms.
