[REDACTED] Events Leading: [REDACTED] was in the comfort room and refused to come out. Another client was needing some time to clear her head and asked if [REDACTED] would come out so that client could go in the room . [REDACTED] said no and acted like she was trying to go to sleep. They started arguing and exchanging words and were separated . we tried to send most of the girls to the back to go into a safe area by going to their room and [REDACTED] was threatening and cussing at everyone to get a reaction 7:00pm: Personal Restraint: the client became unsafe in the house a threat to safety and herself. 7:02pm: Personal Restraint End: the patient was escorted to unlocked seclusion to try to keep her safe and not a threat 7:03pm: Unlocked Seclusion: patient was put in unlocked seclusion and monitored thoroughly 7:04pm: Unlocked Seclusion End: out of seclusion , patient seemed to be calm enough for staff to trust her to make the right choices. Client Debriefing date/time: 05/26/24 7:15pm: we were able to help the patient decompress and talk out their feelings . Was able to get her to open up about some stuff that really makes her mad. Nursing assessment date/time: 05/26/24 7:25pm: Patient found sitting calmly in a chair at a table in the house. Patient denies pain or injury and is calm and cooperative with a depressed affect. Will monitor as needed. Guardian was notified on 05/26/24 at 8:06pm and 8:37pm Client was transferred to Pinnacle Pointe for an acute stay on 05/27/24 at 1:30am. Client will return to Youth Home from acute at this time.

Interim Action Narrative: Staff placed resident in a personal restraint and escorted resident to seclusion room until she could calm down. Resident was transported to Pinnacle Pointe for an acute stay.
