Report Description: Resident, [REDACTED], was sent to Forrest City Medical Center by order Physician for psych evaluation due to self-harm behaviors including wrapping a cable cord around his throat and stating "I want to die" for approximately one minute. Red discoloration and one scratch noted with no other injuries. Breathes even. Columbia Suicide Screening completed with a score of four. The maintenance team has since put the cord backed further into the ceiling and blocked off access to the cord from the ceiling. The cord's necessity is being evaluated to determine if it can be removed. Resident refused transportation to Forrest City Medical Center but was transported via ambulance. Resident's caseworker was at Forrest City Medical Center with Resident. Resident was accepted into Acute (Perimeter Behavioral West Memphis) and transport is expected today at 0800 (8:00 am cst) from Forrest City Medical Center.
