****Sex Offense reported Hotline****

On 06/12/24 a Child Abuse report was received from Arkansas State Police Investigator, Trace Eike, in regards to a new report. Both suspect and victim, are currently residing at the Perimeter Behavioral of the Ozarks. Referral # 2274077

The following is a summary of the DHS Snapshot report:

Alleged Victim is 16-year-old, [REDACTED]. The PRFC is [REDACTED].

Alleged Offender is 15-year-old, [REDACTED]. The other person mentioned is 13-year-old, [REDACTED] are residents at Perimeter Behavioral of the Ozarks and live in the same unit, which is where the alleged events occurred.

On 06/11/2024, the Patient Advocate collected two grievance forms for [REDACTED]. The first was filled out on 06/06/2024 and detailed an incident that allegedly occurred on 05/31/2024. The form stated, "[REDACTED] forced me to touch him and I did not like it and it made me uncomfortable and he made me kiss him too." The second was also filled out on 06/06/2024 and detailed an incident that occurred that day; it stated, "[REDACTED] forced me to kiss her and she keeps touching me when I asked her to stop, she wouldn't. She makes me uncomfortable." An interview with [REDACTED] on 06/11/2024 provided the following details regarding the 05/31/2024 incident:

"I was in my bedroom and [REDACTED] came to the door and asked to talk. When I came over, he grabbed my hand and forced me to touch his privates (chest and genital area). He then grabbed the back of my head and forced me to kiss him.

Description:

At 1:30 P.M. on 12 June 2024 I met with Sarah King and Trace Eike, both employees of Arkansas State Police Crimes Against Children at Perimeter of the Ozarks where [REDACTED] was interviewed. The interview was audio recorded and uploaded to Axon.

[REDACTED] foster family is in Dover, Ohio. She was staying in the blue wing at Perimeter, but has now been moved to the green wing to separate her. [REDACTED] has only been at Perimeter for a few months.

[REDACTED] spoke about [REDACTED] first. They became friends for a little bit, but then "she became too touchy" and [REDACTED] didn't like that. Recently, [REDACTED] was in her own room and [REDACTED] came to her doorway. She asked to talk, and asked [REDACTED] to come there. She forced [REDACTED] to kiss her and she wrote a grievance. [REDACTED] is 13 years old.

[REDACTED] was asked what she meant by touchy, she said it was not inappropriate but just touching her in general.

At the time of the incident, [REDACTED] was alone in her room, her roommate was in the day room. Nothing was said by [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] was pushed toward [REDACTED] lips by her hands, she used two hands. [REDACTED] asked why she did that, and [REDACTED] said "I like you." [REDACTED] said she doesn't like that, and [REDACTED] said she doesn't care so [REDACTED] wrote a grievance.

[REDACTED] then explained the incident with [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] were best friends at one point for about three or four weeks [REDACTED] was in her room putting pictures on her wall. Earlier in the day [REDACTED] was mad at [REDACTED] for calling her a "purple bitch" because she turns purple when cold.

[REDACTED] approached and asked to talk. [REDACTED] sat in the doorway and [REDACTED] sat next to her. [REDACTED] grabbed [REDACTED] hand and forced her to touch her breasts and vagina under the clothes. [REDACTED] said "[REDACTED]" but didn't stop, so [REDACTED] tried to pull away. [REDACTED] forced [REDACTED] hand to continue. [REDACTED] forced [REDACTED] to kiss her the same way that [REDACTED] did.

[REDACTED] had said "I'm going to kiss you" and [REDACTED] replied "No your not", [REDACTED] then said "wanna bet?" before forcing [REDACTED] to kiss her. After, she said don't tell anyone or I would have someone beat you up.

Description:

I received two video files from Charriot Sales, Director of Risk Management, on 13 June 2024. One is for May 31 during the time the offense with [REDACTED] is alleged, and the other for June 6 when the offense with [REDACTED] is alleged. Charriot said that [REDACTED] claimed that [REDACTED] forced her to kiss, and wanted to be [REDACTED] girlfriend. [REDACTED] denied all claims made by [REDACTED]. Charriot also explained that the girls are seen in the doorway because they are not allowed to enter another resident's room.

In the video's [REDACTED] room is the second on the left. [REDACTED] is wearing the blue scrubs. [REDACTED] approaches [REDACTED] doorway and stands there at 3:45 into the video. There are two staff members and multiple residents in the hallway that continually walk past [REDACTED] and [REDACTED]. For the duration of the video [REDACTED] is seen standing in the doorway, only the back of her head, her back, and legs are visible. She leaves at 26:29 in the video. Staff interacted with [REDACTED] multiple, there are no abrupt or odd body movements to made by [REDACTED] during this time. There was no visible evidence to corroborate [REDACTED] statements.

In the June 6 video [REDACTED] approaches [REDACTED] doorway at 2:02 into the video. She is wearing black, and sits down. At one point [REDACTED] gets up and gets a blanket and sits down again. She gets up at 16:35 and walks away. There are staff and residents continually walking through the hallway. There was no visible evidence of [REDACTED] forcibly kissing [REDACTED].

Charriot said the victim and suspects were to remain separated.

Description:

There were two separate incidents alleged by the victim. Video evidence from the days and times given cannot see the victim in frame, and can only partially view the suspect. Staff and residents are continuously walking past the suspect and victim during both videos. In the video there is no evidence to support the victim's statements. Both suspects denied any inappropriate touching or kissing occurred when asked by staff. Due to the suspect's custodial status with DHS they cannot be interviewed. There is insufficient evidence to develop probable cause to arrest for either incident. Perimeter of the Ozarks has separated the victim from both offenders and states they will not cohabitate again.

On 17 June 2024 Trace Eike and Sara King interviewed [REDACTED] at Perimeter of the Ozarks. They were able to get permission from [REDACTED] custodian. [REDACTED] denied there was any physical contact in a sexual nature with another resident, and then requested a lawyer. The audio was uploaded to Axon.
