Report Description: On 6/17/2024 [REDACTED] in the evening around 1800, while outside the resident climbed on the awning to retrieve football. He had been redirected by staff to not do this. The resident got the football and jumped down hearing a "pop" in his ankle. He was immediately assessed and the APRN was called. His left ankle was noted to be extremely swollen, and he was taken to urgent care of x-ray. Resident was taken to urgent care [REDACTED]. He was placed in a cast and will follow-up with Dr. Patterson at Ozark Orthopedics on June 24th. Resident will be treated for pain according to physician orders.

Licensing Narrative: 6/20/2024 - The provider reported incident was reviewed by the Licensing Specialist, Licensing specialist will follow up with the facility if any changes will be made to the outdoor awning as a preventative measure. 6/20/2024- Licensing specialist received correspondence from the facility "Please note that the resident would not follow staff direction to stop. We have reviewed modifications multiple times throughout the years. Because of a patient rights issue of not having to walk exposed to weather elements during

inclement weather, we have kept the awning up. Staff will continue to redirect residents of the safety issue related to climbing. "
