Description:

On 6/19/24 a report was received from Arkansas State Police Investigator Misty Dunn and Deidre Uselton in regards to a new report.

The DHS snapshot was reviewed and the following is a summary of the report.

AV is 12 YO [REDACTED]. AJO is 11YO [REDACTED]. PRFCs are [REDACTED] and [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] are residents at Perimeter Behavioral of the Ozarks and live on the same unit, which is where the alleged event occurred. On 06/18/24, the Director of Risk was questioning [REDACTED] regarding an unrelated topic, when [REDACTED] reported she had been assaulted two nights earlier. She stated her roommate, [REDACTED], woke her up in the middle of the night and allegedly fingered her while sitting on top of her. An interview with [REDACTED] on 06/18/24 provided the following details. [REDACTED] stated the incident did occur, but [REDACTED] was the victim. She reported she woke up in the middle of the night with [REDACTED] on top of her, touching her breast and trying to touch her butt. Both individuals reportedly told the other resident to stop, and they didn't. Residents have been separated with each sleeping on another unit while the investigation is ongoing.

Description:

On June 20, 2024 I went to Perimeter Behavioral Health with CACD Investigator Uselton to interview [REDACTED] (W/F, [REDACTED]) about an incident that she reported involving her roommate [REDACTED] advised she woke up to [REDACTED] on top of her "fingering her".

CACD Investigator Uselton lead the interview by gaining rapport with [REDACTED] and asked her about the incident. [REDACTED] began by saying she put her mattress on the floor due to not liking sleeping next to the window. [REDACTED] said she was wearing a tank top, sports bra, shorts, and no underwear. [REDACTED] said she was asleep and woke up "she was on top of me and fingering me. I felt uncomfortable." Uselton then asked what [REDACTED] believed fingering means and [REDACTED] said "she was touching my lower parts", and then demonstrated an up and down motion with her fingers. [REDACTED] went on to say " she was touching my lower parts inside of my clothes, and her fingers were going in the hole." Uselton then asked what made [REDACTED] stop? [REDACTED] said " I said stop stop stop and she never stopped until I pushed her off and she fell into her bed." Uselton asked who she told. [REDACTED] said she could not remember the staff that she told the incident happened because " I have a bad memory". I took note of this statement because while gaining rapport it was impressive how many details [REDACTED] was able to describe about her family, friends, and incidents that have happened in the past. I also noted there were several bruises, cuts, and scabs all over the legs of [REDACTED] then pointed to some of the bruises on her knees and lower legs and said [REDACTED] had given her those bruises by holding her down while she was fingering her.

Uselton continued to let [REDACTED] speak and this is when the story became more elaborate. [REDACTED] then advised Uselton that [REDACTED] had touched her head, neck, chest, and behind. [REDACTED] demonstrated a caressing motion on her ear and neck. [REDACTED] went on to say [REDACTED] had used her hands to move her shirt and shorts and began to lick her. [REDACTED] described [REDACTED] tongue as licking her neck, chest, and lower, and butt. [REDACTED] said that when this was going on she was asleep and began to wake up, but could not. When she tried to wake up, [REDACTED] said she did not think much of it because she thought it was just a dream. [REDACTED] then went on to say she had a scratch on her lower and was bleeding a little bit. [REDACTED] also said this was the second of two events and the first time she told staff and again could not remember who she told. Uselton then concluded the interview.

Once [REDACTED] was turned over to staff the new director of the facility came and spoke with Uselton and myself. The director wanted to clarify information that she had originally gave to Uselton about reviewing security footage and advising [REDACTED] had came out of the room and spoke to staff on the day of the incident. The director advised [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] have a very similar body type and hair color. The director advised on the 16th [REDACTED] did not come out of her room. The 16th being the night the incident was said to happen. The director did advise [REDACTED] came in and out of the room until lights out time and there was no movement after lights out. The director also advised she knew [REDACTED] to be a bit of a story teller. Uselton and myself advised during the interview [REDACTED] did ask Uselton to check with the staff to see if she could have her own room. The director advised the clients will do many things to try and change their room accommodations.

At the conclusion of the discussion Investigator Uselton advised she did not feel comfortable pursuing the report any further.

I also spoke with juvenile prosecutor Claire who advised charges would not be filed. At this time I am labeling this case as inactive. (END NARRATIVE D387)
