On June 22, 2024 at approximately 1313 hours, I was talking with a female inside Springdale lobby, later identified as Renee Des Plains (W/F-DOB) who stated she worked at Perimeter Behavioral and was assaulted by a patient there. Plains wrote a statement regarding the incident that happened.

Plains stated she was a traveling Registered Nurse (RN) and was working at Perimeter Behavioral on this day which is a mental rehabilitaion facility for children of varying ages. Plains told me that one of the patients is a 17 YOA female had broken a comb and attempted to stab one of the staff members with it earlier that day. Plains alongside other staff members informed the female, later identified as (W/F-DOB:), that causing harm to any staff member as well as other residents is a crime. Around this time, other RN's came into the unit Plains informed her that she would need to find a coping mechanism to help calm down. then punched Plains in the face with a closed fist and attempted to attack her but was pulled away by other staff members that were in the unit. I asked Plains if she sustained any injury from the altercation to which she stated she did and that there was an injury to her right shoulder. She had taken a picture of it and it was documented. After talking with Plains, I informed her that I would be going out to Perimeter to talk with as well as other staff members to see what happened. When I arrived at Perimeter, the superintendent of the facility, Jennifer, allowed us inside the facility and walked us to room, where she had come out of the room to talk with us. I informed why I was there, telling her that we got a report involving her in a fight with a nurse on duty. I asked her what happened and told me that she did in fact hit Plains in the face. I asked her why and she just said she was angry. I asked who her guardian is when Jennifer told me it was . I got her information and told Jennifer that she could go back to her room. After was returned to her room, I talked with Jennifer about what happened. She stated the same story as both and Plains but had added that Plains was push up against one of the doors in the facility, which caused the injury to Plains' shoulder. I informed her that I would make contact with the Juvenile Detention Center (JDC) to determine was 17. I asked who would be taking what they wanted to do since to her court date and was told it would be Sarah Whorton, who is a Superintendent at Perimeter. I called JDC and informed them that would be charged with Battery 2nd for causing injury to a healthcare worker. JDC then informed me that if Perimeter was fine with it, then she would just be released and cited for the offense. Perimeter was fine with being released back into their custody since they were seperated and I was given a court date from JDC for July 8th, 2024 at 1015 hours at 885 Clydesdale Dr in Fayetteville for . JDC also stated that if she did anything else, then JDC would take her into custody. I made contact with Jennifer and informed

her that we would be releaing back to them and gave her the eCite, showing her the court

and informed her the same

date, time, and location for court. I then spoke with

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information.

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After eCite was given and management notified, I left the facility and notified dispatch about the call and cleared it. About 15 minutes later, I was dispatched to Perimeter again regarding stating that she had struck other staff members when they were trying to take her to another unit. I arrived back at that location and made contact with Jennifer again. She told me that was punching and kicking other staff members but no injuries were seen. The staff members that were assaulted by did not want to press charges against her. I called JDC and informed them that had started punching and kicking other staff members and that I was informed by JDC that they would take her. JDC told me they would take her and I was given a Detention Hearing of June 24th, 2024 at 0800 hours. I confirmed with JDC that there would be no additional charges added to the existing eCite and they stated that was fine and they would still take her.

I placed under arrest, placed handcuffs on her checking for fit and double-locking them, and patted her down before putting her in the police car. I took her to Springdale Jail where I filled out a Preliminary Report. While I was there, I called JDC an additional time to make sure they were taking her for the one charge of Battery 2nd and nothing else. They again confirmed that was fine and still wanted her. Since this portion of the incident was on a different incident call, along with given a different court date, I voided out the original eCite and wrote up another with the correct date of June 24, 2024 at 0800 hours. I gave a copy to Jennifer and informed her that this was the correct eCite.
