On 6/20 CACD Inv Misty Dunn interviewed alleged victim at Perimeter in Springdale. Following is a summary. After building rapport and establishing family dynamics, was explaining what unit she was on and stated that she just moved and had to sleep in the day room. She said that two different people explained that she was moved because some people were lying on her and saying that she was fingering them. was her roommate before she was moved, and said this. is one of the girls that lied on her. stated that a said that airl named explained that fingered her is 15 years old. . She stated that she was standing in the doorway of is put her hand into pants and inserted her fingers into room in the orange unit, where the cameras couldn't see, and stated that she told to stop, and she didn't. moved her hand around when touching her vagina. stated vagina. said it stopped when staff came by. stated this happened a long time ago and she told staff at Perimeter about it stated she didn't want investigator to ask about what happened because she doesn't want to be upset. stated that she and are both in foster care out of Texas. denied that anyone else had touched her body when it wasn't ok with her. denied that anyone made her touch their denied anyone has shown her pictures or videos of people without clothes and denied that anyone has wanted pictures of her without body. denied that anyone has done anything to hurt her or leave a mark. denied any knowledge of drug or alcohol use. clothes On 7/18 CACD Inv Misty Dunn interviewed alleged offender at Perimeter. Her attorney, Amanda Lesinski was present by phone. Following was read her juvenile miranda rights and signed indicating she understood those rights. agreed to speak with is a summary. and stated that is another resident at Perimeter and used to be on the investigator. stated that she knows alleged victim same unit as her. stated there was a situation where two girls lied on her and said that she touched inappropriately. stated that they said that she put her hand in stated that never happened. private, meaning vagina. stated that lied on her, but she doesn't know why. stated she's been accused of this once before in another facility, but she doesn't know what the findings stated that people lied on her that time. On 7/18 CACD Inv Misty Dunn spoke with Amanda Lesinski by telephone after interviewing alleged offender Amanda stated that she has been attorney for 6 years, so she knows her pretty well. She stated that when attorney has done something, if she is confronted, she will usually admit what she did. Amanda stated that she is comfortable with attorney denial and stated that she is inclined to believe her.

On 7/18 CACD Inv Misty Dunn spoke with the Director of Risk at Perimeter, Chariot Sales. Chariot stated she feels like this incident between AV and AO happened but stated that she thinks it was consensual. She stated that some of the girls like to experiment sexually, and they are in and out of relationships. When one gets mad at the other, the girls will lie.
