Description:

On 6/27/24 a report was received from Arkansas State Police Investigator Misty Dunn in regards to a new report.

The DHS snapshot was reviewed and the following is a summary of the report.

AV is 12yo [REDACTED]. A/O is [REDACTED] (per following info a/o is a minor, but no age/DOB provided by reporter). PRFC is [REDACTED]. AV is 12-year-old [REDACTED]. AO is a peer [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] are both residents at Perimeter in Springdale and both are in foster care out of Texas. AV disclosed that she was standing in the doorway of [REDACTED] room when [REDACTED] put her hand down AV's pants and inserted her fingers into AV's vagina. AV reported telling [REDACTED] to stop but [REDACTED] kept doing it. [REDACTED] had previously been questioned about this incident by staff and by her foster care worker and denied that anything like this happened to both.

Description:

On July 24, 2024 I was forwarded the summaries of the interviews of all the subjects involved by Investigator Dunn. The summaries were forwarded to



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me as follows...

On 6/20 CACD Inv Misty Dunn interviewed alleged victim [REDACTED] at Perimeter in Springdale. Following is a summary. After building rapport and establishing family dynamics, [REDACTED] was explaining what unit she was on and stated that she just moved and had to sleep in the day room. She explained that she was moved because some people were lying on her and saying that she was fingering them. [REDACTED] said that two different people said this. [REDACTED] said that [REDACTED] was her roommate before she was moved, and [REDACTED] is one of the girls that lied on her. [REDACTED] stated that a girl named [REDACTED] fingered her [REDACTED] is 15 years old. [REDACTED] explained that [REDACTED] is [REDACTED]. She stated that she was standing in the doorway of [REDACTED] room in the orange unit, where the cameras couldn't see, and [REDACTED] put her hand into [REDACTED] pants and inserted her fingers into [REDACTED] vagina. [REDACTED] stated that she told [REDACTED] to stop, and she didn't. [REDACTED] stated [REDACTED] moved her hand around when touching her vagina. [REDACTED] said it stopped when staff came by. [REDACTED] stated this happened a long time ago and she told staff at Perimeter about it. [REDACTED] stated she didn't want investigator to ask [REDACTED] about what happened because she doesn't want [REDACTED] to be upset. [REDACTED] stated that she and [REDACTED] are both in foster care out of Texas. [REDACTED] denied that anyone else had touched her body when it wasn't ok with her. [REDACTED] denied that anyone made her touch their body. [REDACTED] denied anyone has shown her pictures or videos of people without clothes and denied that anyone has wanted pictures of her without clothes. [REDACTED] denied that anyone has done anything to hurt her or leave a mark. [REDACTED] denied any knowledge of drug or alcohol use.

On 7/18 CACD Inv Misty Dunn interviewed alleged offender [REDACTED] at Perimeter. Her attorney, Amanda Lesinski was present by phone. Following is a summary. [REDACTED] was read her juvenile miranda rights and signed indicating she understood those rights. [REDACTED] agreed to speak with investigator. [REDACTED] stated that she knows alleged victim [REDACTED] and stated that [REDACTED] is another resident at Perimeter and used to be on the same unit as her. [REDACTED] stated there was a situation where two girls lied on her and said that she touched [REDACTED] inappropriately. [REDACTED] stated that they said that she put her hand in [REDACTED] private, meaning vagina. [REDACTED] stated that never happened. [REDACTED] stated that [REDACTED] lied on her, but she doesn't know why. [REDACTED] stated she's been accused of this once before in another facility, but she doesn't know what the findings were. [REDACTED] stated that people lied on her that time. When confronted with the fact that [REDACTED], all three said the incident happened, [REDACTED] continued to deny it. [REDACTED] asked if she and [REDACTED] could be back on the same unit when the investigation was completed and was advised that was a decision that Perimeter would make. CACD 212A emailed to [REDACTED] caseworker.

On 6/20 CACD Inv Misty Dunn spoke with Chariot Sales at Perimeter. Chariot stated that two children had come to staff saying that [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] were seen fingering each other. She stated that they questioned both girls and both girls denied it. Chariot stated they don't have a good time frame from the witnesses to watch camera footage.

On 6/25 CACD Inv Misty Dunn spoke with Chariot Sales at Perimeter. Chariot stated she spoke with alleged victim [REDACTED] about the alleged incident with [REDACTED]. Chariot stated she was trying to get a time frame from [REDACTED] of when the reported incident happened so that she could watch video footage and [REDACTED] could not give her a good time frame.

On 6/20 CACD Inv Misty Dunn spoke with [REDACTED] by telephone. [REDACTED] is [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] stated that she had talked with alleged victim [REDACTED] earlier in the day about the reported incident concerning [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] stated that [REDACTED] denied that she or [REDACTED] had touched each other. [REDACTED] stated that [REDACTED] parental rights have been terminated. [REDACTED] is in foster care out of Texas. [REDACTED] stated that [REDACTED] can be interviewed as an alleged offender.

On 7/18 CACD Inv Misty Dunn spoke with [REDACTED] at Perimeter in Springdale. Following is a summary. [REDACTED] stated that she saw alleged victim [REDACTED] and alleged offender [REDACTED] sitting in the doorway of room 203, side by side, with their hands down the other's pants. She stated that they were touching each other inappropriately. [REDACTED] stated that she didn't hear them say anything to each other, but it looked like [REDACTED] was trying to pull [REDACTED] hand out of her pants, but she doesn't know for sure. [REDACTED] stated that she immediately went and told staff



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what was happening.

On 7/18 CACD Inv Misty Dunn spoke with Amanda Lesinski by telephone after interviewing alleged offender [REDACTED]. Amanda stated that she has been [REDACTED] attorney for 6 years, so she knows her pretty well. She stated that when [REDACTED] has done something, if she is confronted, she will usually admit what she did. Amanda stated that she is comfortable with [REDACTED] denial and stated that she is inclined to believe her.

On 7/18 CACD Inv Misty Dunn spoke with the Director of Risk at Perimeter, Chariot Sales. Chariot stated she feels like this incident between AV [REDACTED] and AO [REDACTED] happened but stated that she thinks it was consensual. She stated that some of the girls like to experiment sexually, and they are in and out of relationships. When one gets mad at the other, the girls will lie.
