Report Description: Resident, [REDACTED], engaged in self-injurious behaviors by collecting a small piece of broken glass. Resident asked three other Residents to cut him after attempting to cut himself. Two rejected his request and one decided to after trading the request for a snack. The cut resulted in bleeding, and the Resident was transported to Forrest City Medical Center. All clocks have been reviewed to ensure no residual glass is present. Existing glass will be removed from the clocks. Resident is currently on line of sight supervision. Resident and peer who performed the cut have been separated and Hall's changed. Resident and peer were interviewed separately by the Safety Team. Residents were asked how likely they were to self-harm again and/or ask any Resident for assistance to which they both replied, "they do not know." Psychoeducation around self-harming/self-harm ideations, as well as bodily injuries was completed by the Clinical Director and Director of Nursing. Both Residents also were also assessed by their Therapist 07/01/2024. Both Residents will undergo daily body checks by the Nursing team to assess for any self-harm injuries until further notice.
