Leading: Client was excited about the fireworks outing. Client later learned that she was not on the list to go on said outing. Client became extremely upset about this news and went into her closet, refused to come out, hitting the wall with her crocs, kicking the wall and yelling at staff every time they tried talking to her. Client went from using her feet to using her hand to bang on the wall leaving some bruising on her hand. Nursing Assessment 1 date/time: 07/04/24 9:48pm: Nurse came to Mabee house d/t call stating that pt had gotten angry that they could not go on outing and punched wall in closet. Upon assessment, pt is sitting in corner of closet with knees to chest. Pt refusing to verbally communicate w/ this RN. Upon assessment, pt is alert and able to follow verbal communication. Full ROM in both hands, grip strength even. Bruising noted to R hand, last 3 fingers (middle, ring, pinky) bruised at the knuckle, swelling noted to R side of hand. Pt is able to move fingers with some pain, expresses pain when area above knuckles of middle, ring, and pinky finger are touched by this RN. Pt denies any further injury. No further s/sx of injury noted. Skin intact. Pt is able to walk to nurses station for ice pack w/o difficulty. Pt told to keep ice on area, rest hand, use ibu/acet as needed per MAR for pain. Pt nodded to nurses instruction. Given ice pack. Refused ibu/acet at this time. Notified provider on call. Treatment team notified to reassess in AM to see if swelling has worsened/improved. No further needs at this time. Nursing Assessment 2 date/time: 07/05/24 10:05am: no s/sx of acute distress. resp even/unlabored. cooperative. c/o pain to R hand after hitting the wall yesterday. R hand noted with discoloration and swelling at the 3d - 5th digit knuckle area. cap refills < 3 sec. pain with ROM. [REDACTED] [REDACTED] APRN notified, ordered to take pt to UC for R hand pain

evaluation, which was changed late in the day to ACH ED due to pt insurance. ibuprofen given per orders, ice pack provided. staff notified of the orders. awaiting for staff transport Nursing Assessment 3 date/time: 07/05/24 7:44pm: The patient returned from the ER at 7:44 pm with no signs or symptoms of acute distress. A focused assessment revealed respiration was even and unlabored, and the patient was cooperative. The right hand showed discoloration and swelling in the knuckle area of the 3rd to 5th digits, with capillary refill less than 3 seconds and mild pain reported with range of motion. Per ER records, the diagnosis [REDACTED]. The ER recommended rotating ibuprofen and Tylenol for pain and using ice packs. The on-call MD was informed of the patient's return at 8:02 pm and agreed with the ER recommendations. The patient's mother was notified at 8:05 pm and had no concerns. The patient had received ibuprofen at 7:20 pm before leaving the ER and reported no additional complaints or concerns upon return. Guardian was contacted on 07/04/24 at 10:26pm, 07/05/24 at 1:31pm, 3:35pm, and 8:05pm ER Paperwork will be emailed to [REDACTED] [REDACTED] when received in Medical Records.
