[REDACTED] submitted statements to the Director of Risk (DOR) regarding the alleged sexual misconduct of peer [REDACTED] [REDACTED] in which [REDACTED] reports, ?they would bend me over and touch my boobs and butt and flash me and try to see me change like holding my bathroom door open and looking.? The DOR verified [REDACTED] was assigned her own room and staff was in ratio. On the morning of 07/17/24, the DOR interviewed the youth. During [REDACTED] interview, she claimed that on multiple occasions [REDACTED] touched her breast and butt and laughs off her attempts to say no. She also reported [REDACTED] has flashed her breast at [REDACTED] a couple of times and has tried to hold her bathroom door open while she is changing. Both [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] stated they witnessed this

The tech can be seen sitting at the table, working and supervising residents. Tech goes down the hallway to assist the other staff processing with a resident for approx. 1 minute. During this time 4 residents can be seen moving towards the hygiene closet. The victim [REDACTED] proceeds to bend over and "twerk" on another resident [REDACTED]. Then another resident enters the room [REDACTED] and the residents can be seen dancing and "twerking" in the middle of the dayroom. The victim [REDACTED] can be seen receiving what appear to be a kiss from resident [REDACTED]. Tech reenters to dayroom from the hallway and residents disperse and continue with personal time. 7/22/2024 - Licensing specialist spoke with facility staff in regards to the case and implementing a new routine for supervision and more structure in the hygiene time. The facility will provide documentation of this implement by Friday 7/26/2024. 7/24/2024- Licensing specialist reached out to the facility in regards to signing the 521 inspection report which was sent 7/22/2024. The staff reenters the dayroom from the hallway and residents disperse and continue with personal time.
