Notice of Serious Incident

Report Description: On 08.07.24, Little Creek was informed of a complaint by an unknown offender by [REDACTED]. The complaint was an abuse and neglect case for [REDACTED] stating she was overly medicated and lying in her vomit, and unresponsive in return, receiving no help from nursing or other staff members here at Little Creek.

Interim Action Narrative: Per report, the reporter is unknown.

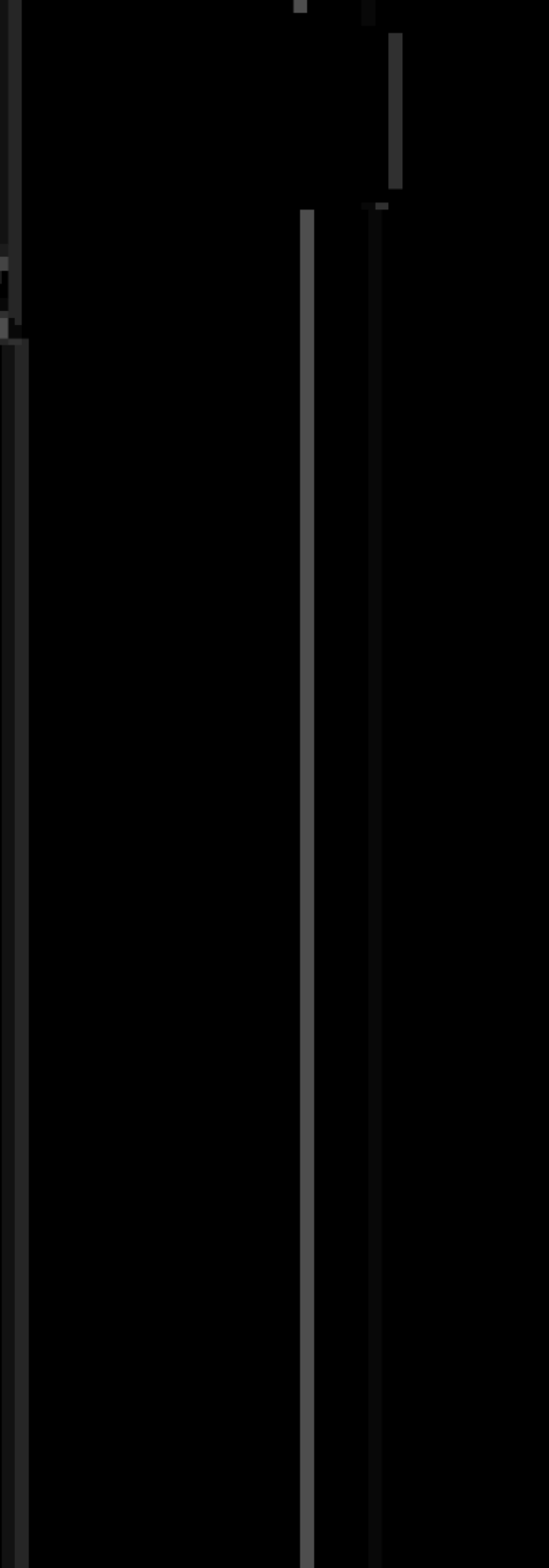
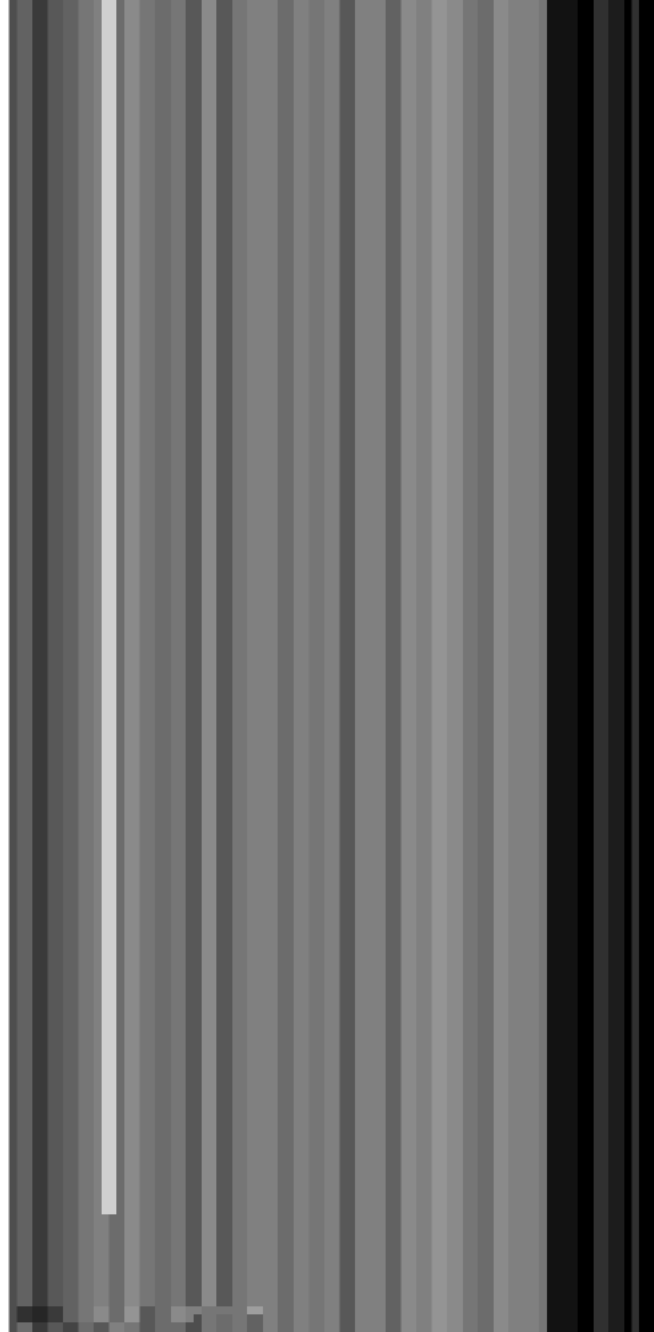
Maltreatment Narrative: AV is ~14yo [REDACTED]. AO is unknown (employee at Little Creek Behavioral Health). [REDACTED] is being overmedicated with the daily medications. They put her on a bunch of different medications to control her behavior until they can get her moved around. She was prescribed the medications. The facility is giving her more medications than she is prescribed. The medications are for her mood. [REDACTED] has been unresponsive before and they did not call 911. The staff have asked to send her out to the hospital, but the supervisors have said no she is just overmedicated. She is stumbling around and throwing up. They are letting her just lay in her throw up and she is having to be fed. She is having to be helped up and to the bathroom. [REDACTED] has been in this serious state since Saturday. They don't call the police or ambulance when she is unresponsive. Her respirations were off all day after she became responsive, and they still wouldn't send her to the hospital. The supervisor said that she would be medicated like this until they could ship her out of there. [REDACTED] has been sleeping on the floor on a mattress but when DHS comes in, they pick her up and put her on a cot. The nurses and supervisors are all in on this

situation. Everyone in charge is choosing to do this. There is concern for [REDACTED] health as she has been unresponsive on at least one occasion.

Licensing Narrative: Program Coordinator received an email from investigator regarding maltreatment and accompanying her on the interview. Program Coordinator received documentation from the facility. Risk Management and the DON discussed the resident's behavior and the possibility of who made the hotline call. 8/9/2024, Program Coordinator will request the nursing notes for 8/1/2024 to 8/7/2024. Facility provided a copy of an assessment dated 8/2/2024. 9/6/2024, checked CHRIS case is still pending. 9/17/2024, per CHRIS case is still pending. 9/26/2024, per CHRIS case found unsubstantiated. Case complete.







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
