Description:

I received the video from State Police Investigator Ying Merritt of the incident at Perimeter of the Ozarks. The video was placed in a digital case file.

Watching the video there is a disturbance involving several staff members and residents. There is no audio, but it appears that Staff members are watching three females creating some type of disturbance. The Staff members watch the females up until the females start using books to attempt to break lights from the ceiling. At that point several Staff members attempt to restrain the females. [REDACTED] who is listed as the victim in this case is taken to the floor by several staff members. According to Perimeter a recommended restraint method is for three staff members to restrain someone out of control. One staff member on each arm and one staff member lays across the person's legs. In the video [REDACTED] is laying face up and three staff members are restraining her using the above method. [REDACTED] head is blocked from the camera view, but it is clear that she is breathing by watching [REDACTED] stomach going up and down. The person who [REDACTED] claims was choking her was holding her left arm with one hand on [REDACTED] wrist and the other was not in view. It is clear that the staff members were trying to focus on restraining [REDACTED] and the other two females. [REDACTED] also complained that another staff member kicked [REDACTED] in the head on purpose.

[REDACTED] head is blocked from camera view however a female staff member did walk by and did something with her foot. According to interviews of the staff members their intent was trying to restrain the females and not harm them. There is no evidence that any of the staff's intentions were to harm [REDACTED] or the other females.

CID Sergeant Niccum and Sergeant Hammontree both watched the video and agreed that there was no evidence of a crime, and this case could be closed.
