[REDACTED] Events Leading: While walking back to the house from dinner client and two other peers quickly rushed pass staff in efforts to elope. Staff quickly followed protocol while also ensuring safety of client's remaining. When client was brought back to the house: client had a smirk on his face due to being caught by PCSD. Client stated "It was dumb what I did, I don't know what I am thinking about. It was hot". Client and peers made a makeshift bag of his peer's jeans. Client stated that they went into a bandit house and found two blades, screwdriver and a pill bottle. Nursing Assessment date/time: 08/17/24 9:20pm Patient assessed following elopement. Multiple pink scratches legs bilaterally. Also multiple pink and round bug bites to right and left leg. No open bleeding noted. Small scratches to wrist areas of both arms. Upper body examined. No bruising or open scratches noted. Guardian was notified on 08/17/24 at 9:28pm

Interim Action Narrative: The police were called and the resident was assessed by the nurse upon his return.

Maltreatment Narrative:

Licensing Narrative: Licensing reviewed provider reported incident for licensing concerns. Program Coordinator inquired about nursing notes, if a police report number was provided, and safety precautions. Facility reported that resident was placed on run risk, house restriction, and freeze. Nursing note was provided and uploaded. 8/20/2024, Program Coordinator requested police documentation.
