****Sex Offense reported Hotline****

On 08/22/24 a Child Abuse report was received from Arkansas State Police Investigator, Deidre Uselton, in regards to a new report. Referral [REDACTED].

The DHS snapshot was reviewed and the following is a summary of the report:

Alleged Victim is [REDACTED] (13 yr.); The Alleged Offender is a peer at Perimeter Behavioral of the Ozarks ([REDACTED] 15 yr.). [REDACTED] is a resident at Perimeter Behavioral of the Ozarks and was interviewed on another referral [REDACTED] and disclosed that approximately 3 months ago another resident, [REDACTED] had made [REDACTED] finger her and then [REDACTED] fingered [REDACTED]. She said it was in the doorway of the room when staff would walk the other way. [REDACTED] said there was a look out, but she could not remember who. [REDACTED] said she touched [REDACTED] under the clothes and [REDACTED] touched her under the clothes. She said it happened one time.

Description:

On 08/21/24, I was assigned this case. Reading the email chain, it appeared that this case was initiated during an interview by CACD while conducting an interview for a different case. I then made contact with Deidre Uselton, who conducted the interview. I was notified that she was in the process of typing the report. Uselton stated that there was nothing of substance for law enforcement to initiate an investigation. She stated that the victim had stated she was "forced" to engage in sexual activity with another person but was unable to articulate any force to substantiate the claim.

I was notified that this incident involves two females from Perimeter of The Ozarks. The females were in the room with a "lookout" when the two engaged in the sexual activity. The victim made the comment that after being "forced" to "finger" the suspect female, she then engaged in "fingering" the other. Uselton stated she would attempt to contact the case worker for the suspect female, in order to conduct an interview. Uselton also stated that there is history with the two females.

Once I receive the narrative for the interview, I will upload it into the case. At this time, there is nothing to substantiate a criminal investigation.

On 09/04/24, I spoke with Uselton about the status of her investigation. She stated that she had been in contact with the attorney of the suspect. The attorney agreed to an interview but wanted to be present. Uselton notified me that she was planning on doing the interview this week and after would send me the narrative. I asked her to notify me of the details and when she closes her case.

On 09/17/24, I received an email from Uselton. The email stated that the listed suspect's attorney declined an interview. At this time, there is no evidence of any crime being committed. Uselton stated she is closing her case as unfounded. I am forwarding this case to my supervisor with a closed status.

This is the narrative sent to me by Deidre Uselton regarding the interview with [REDACTED]

8/20 @ 9:26am

Inv. Uselton conducted a digitally recorded forensic interview with [REDACTED] talked about liking art and drawing people and houses. She said she likes to go to school to see her friends and she is in 8th grade. [REDACTED] said she had been at Perimeter 4 or 5 months. [REDACTED] said she has a dad named [REDACTED] and he lives in Booneville with her stepmom, twin sisters, a sister and a brother. [REDACTED] said her dad has cats and she is allergic to them. [REDACTED] said that last weekend she went to see her dad and when she came back, she had red scratches on her back from scratching [REDACTED] denied that anyone put these scratches on her back but again said she was itching and did it with her hands. She said she thought it might be from being allergic to the cats. [REDACTED] was asked about touches and said that [REDACTED] had fingered her and then made [REDACTED] finger [REDACTED] said this was about 2 or 3 months ago and they were in the doorway of her room. She said it was at nighttime and the staff was in the day room. [REDACTED] said that [REDACTED] made [REDACTED] finger her and she stopped when staff came by. She said that then [REDACTED] fingered her and again stopped when staff came by. [REDACTED] said it was under the clothes on both. She said it only happened that one time and it was not ok with her. [REDACTED] said there was a look out but she did not remember who the resident was. [REDACTED] talked about another resident trying to kiss her but said she did not remember who this was. [REDACTED] said that there had been no other touches that were not ok that she has not already talked about. She was asked about food at the facility and said there is plenty of food. [REDACTED] said her dad's house also has food but sometimes she does not like to eat. She said her stepmom made her hot pockets when she was there last. [REDACTED] said when she is at her dads and breaks a rule, she gets grounded from her phone and her dad talks to her. [REDACTED] said she feels safe at Perimeter and safe at her dads but she wants to live with her foster mom. She said that she is afraid to live with her dad, a male because of what happened to her when she was younger. [REDACTED] said if something happened that was not ok she would tell a person at her school and her [REDACTED].
