Events Leading: Patient was at gym and went to the bathroom and stated she bumped her head on the bathroom door while exiting. Nurse arrive to patient in the gym sitting on floor with staff. Patient verbalizing that her vision is blurry and dizzy. Poor cognition noted. vital unremarkable BP-115/82, Pulse 113, Resp. 18/min, Pulse ox 97%. Waited 15 minutes and rechecked vitals and still unremarkable. Attempted to walk to house and after the stairs patient went limp and lowered to the ground. Reassessed and vitals bp-136/88, resp. 19/min, pulse ox 98%. After 15 minutes two staff attempted to support and walk patient to rose house. Upon entry to rose house began to loose strength and went limp and lowered to the floor. Seizure like presents noted. Nursing Assessment date/time: 08/25/24 6:36pm: Patient presents on rose floor after being walked with two staff supporting from gym post dizziness, double vision reported, and agonal/gasping breathing poor unstable gate noted. Unable to obtain bp due to movement., Respirations 27 per minute of short gasping breaths. Pulse ox 97% on room air. pulse 118. Seizure like presentation noted. Pt unable to provide orientation and utilize conversation at this time. Poor cognition displayed. MEMs notified and transported to ACH by ambulance. Guardian was notified on 08/26/24 at 7:26pm ER paperwork was emailed to on 08/26/24.

Interim Action Narrative: Resident was assessed by the nurse and transported to the ER via MEMS.
