## Primary Narrative By Colten Bradshaw, 09/10/24 16:01

### Battery 3rd Degree

On 09/10/2024 at 1348 hours, I, Deputy Bradshaw, responded to 20400 Colonel Glenn Road in reference to a disturbance.

Upon arrival, I made contact with [REDACTED], who stated [REDACTED] classmate, [REDACTED] had been talking about mother all day. [REDACTED] stated [REDACTED] called [REDACTED] mother a name and he "snapped." [REDACTED] stated [REDACTED] then tackled [REDACTED] and punched him five times in the head.

I made contact with [REDACTED] who stated [REDACTED] stood up and began yelling at him. Price then made [REDACTED] step out of the classroom in the hallway in an attempt to deescalate the situation. [REDACTED] stated after walking into the hallway, [REDACTED] charged at him and tackled him to the ground. [REDACTED] stated he was then struck in the head multiple times by [REDACTED] [REDACTED] complained of soreness to the back of his head, but stated he was not injured during the incident.

I made contact with Price, who stated [REDACTED] sits in front of [REDACTED] in the back of the classroom. Price advised she did not hear or see [REDACTED] turn around and say anything to [REDACTED] Price then observed [REDACTED] stand up and begin yelling at [REDACTED] Price stated she sent [REDACTED] out of the classroom, and observed [REDACTED] run past her, tackle [REDACTED] to the ground, and punch him in the head multiple times.

[REDACTED] was then arrested and contact was made with Juvenile Intake Officer, Martha Carter. Carter provided [REDACTED] with a court date of 10/10/2024 at 1000 hours. After [REDACTED] received [REDACTED] court date, [REDACTED] was released back to school staff.
