Primary Narrative By Keon Leflore, 09/10/24 22:18

Disturbance

On September, 10, 2024 at approximately 1352 hours, I, Deputy K.LeFlore received a call at 20400 Colonel Glenn Road in reference to a disturbance.

Upon my arrival, I met with Caroline Sipes, and she advised me of following:

Durina school hours, Sipes was teaching her class when one of her students, [REDACTED] was interrupting the class room by walking around talking in an aggressive manner around the classroom. Sipes asked [REDACTED] multiple time to be seated at his desk. [REDACTED] proceeded to walk around the classroom ignoring [REDACTED] orders. Once Sipes politely asked [REDACTED] to be seated, [REDACTED] quoted "Bitch make me" and proceeded to aggressively push Sipes while she was seated in her chair.

Secondary teachers, Rasheauna Lambert and Charles Hoof proceeded to restrain [REDACTED] and walk [REDACTED] from out the classroom. While doing so, [REDACTED] turned around a proceeded to hit [REDACTED] classmate, [REDACTED] on the side of his

head with a closed fist. No injuries were reported from [REDACTED] was eventually escorted out the classroom into the hallway by Lambert and Hoof.

Once entering into the hallway, [REDACTED] was very combative, fighting [REDACTED] way from Lambert and Hoof. While doing so, [REDACTED] managed to strike Lambert in the middle of her chest 2x time with a closed first. Lambert advised she was not injured nor did she need medical.

Upon speaking with [REDACTED], [REDACTED] advised [REDACTED] was upset and wanted to talk about unknown problems. [REDACTED] advised [REDACTED] did not mean to harm anyone, but just wanted to be heard of [REDACTED] unknown problems that [REDACTED] did not advise me of.

I, Deputy K.LeFLore contacted the intake Officer of Pulaski County Juvenile Dentition Center, Martha Carter. Carter was given the details of the incident. Carter advised me of the court date for [REDACTED] which is October 2, 2024. [REDACTED] was cited for Battery in the 3rd degree (5-13-203), and was given a court date.
