On September 29th 2024, at approximately 7:48 PM I (Patrol First Class. M. Dickerson #415) was dispatched to 2466 S 48th Street Suite B (Perimeter of the Ozarks) in reference to a disturbance. The caller advised residents were threatening to attack the staff. The caller advised a resident had already attacked one of the nurses thirty minutes before calling.

When I arrived on scene, Officers J. Moore #397 and L. French #367 were speaking with the staff and caller attempting to gather information for the incident. I attempted to review footage of the incident with one of the staff members when she began to run back toward the unit holding the children. Following the nurse back into the containment unit I observed a white male staff member step outside of the unit with a torn shirt and red face visibly distraught. The male individual advised he was just attacked and wanted to press charges on the juvenile that attacked him. Entering into the containment unit I observed several female juveniles being restrained by staff members and the male pointed to one [REDACTED] and advised she was the one who attacked the male staff member.

I advised the staff members to let go of her as she was actively resisting their efforts and myself and Officer L. French #367 replaced the staff members and attempted to get the juvenile to walk out of the containment unit with us. The juvenile verbally refused and demanded to be let go of, we then lifted her up by both arms and waited for her to put her body weight on her legs. The juvenile never put her weight on her legs so we went back to the ground. The juvenile then began to thrash her entire body and writhe on the ground attempting to wrest free her hands from officer's control. Myself and Officer L. French #367 then placed the juvenile's hands

on the small of her back and placed her in handcuffs. Due to the juvenile continually writhing and ignoring warning, I was unable to ensure the fit of the handcuffs but they were double locked. The juvenile was then removed from the containment room where she began to kick at any individual nearby forcing me to catch her legs and restrain them until she ceased lashing out. After everyone stepped away from the juvenile, she was able to calm down a little and I stayed with her and attempted to figure out what had occurred. The juvenile eventually identified herself as [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] did not provide me with any further information about what had occurred, only stating the male staff member had made her angry after restraining her friend and she got mad. When asked about the incident further [REDACTED] began to change the subject. While sitting and talking with me [REDACTED] began to struggle against her cuffs and even after being warned several times, she was only going to cause abrasions to her skin, [REDACTED] wrested her right hand from the handcuffs. I finished taking the handcuffs off and advised her they could stay off if she controlled her violent outbursts as we were in a controlled room and I did not want to risk injury of attempting to slip out of handcuffs for a second time. [REDACTED] required no medical treatment for the slight redness around her wrists.

Officer J. Moore #397 then confirmed there were charges for Battery 3rd and JDC had made the decision to detain [REDACTED] in light of the situation. I then explained the situation to [REDACTED] and placed her in handcuffs again, this time [REDACTED] was more cooperative and the handcuffs were placed on in a manner where I was able to check the fit and ensure they were double locked. For more information concerning the probable cause and victim please refer to Officer J. Moore's #397 narrative.

[REDACTED] was then transported back to Washington County Juvenile Detention Center and handed over into the intake officer's custody.

On September 29, 2024, I (Officer French 367) was dispatched to 2466 South 48th street for a disturbance call. The caller stated 7-8 residents are causing issues and attacking the staff.

Upon arrival, I and Officer Moore 397 made contact with the caller Kristopher Teed [REDACTED]. Kristopher explained that the building is housing about thirty female juveniles. He stated about seven of them are making threats and have attacked the staff before. Once inside the building, the female juveniles are heard yelling and screaming. The juveniles are heard screaming profanities at the staff and officers. The staff member that was attacked was identified as Jaibriel Burke [REDACTED]. The suspect juvenile is identified as [REDACTED].

Jaibriel stated [REDACTED] was in the rec room and started breaking things and throwing stuff around. Jaibriel stated he went in the room to remove [REDACTED] and put her into solitary confinement. Jaibriel stated when he opened the door to enter; [REDACTED] started throwing punches and hitting him in the face and chest area. Jaibriel and other staff members had to physically restrain [REDACTED] but she continued to fight and hit Jaibriel. I observed Jaibriel had abrasions under his right eye and had some of his bread missing from where she pulled some of it out.

While speaking with Jaibriel, juveniles in the rec room started destroying property in the room. Staff members went into the rooms and the juveniles started attacking the staff. Once female juvenile had to be restrained due to attacking Kristopher. Kristopher stated he wanted to press charges so the female juvenile identified as [REDACTED] was detained. [REDACTED] was already being restrained by staff members. I and Officer Dickerson 415 took over by grabbing each of her arms. When attempting to pickup [REDACTED] to her feet, she dropped her weight. When she dropped her weight; officers assisted her to the ground gently. While officer Dickerson moved her hands to the small of her back, I placed her in handcuffs. Once in handcuffs, myself and Officer Moore performed a two on one escort out of the room and placed her in a chair.

While Officer Moore was speaking with staff members and Officer Dickerson was dealing with [REDACTED] I contacted Washington juvenile detention center. I spoke to the intake officer and I advised her of the situation for both juveniles. The intake officer provided me with court dates for [REDACTED]. On 09/29/2024 at approximately 1951 hours I was dispatched to the Perimeter of the Ozarks located at 2466 S 48th St B in regard to a disturbance. The caller, who was later identified as Kris Teed (██████████) advised that there were juvenile residents at the location that were threatening staff members. Teed further advised that one of the juveniles had assaulted one of the staff members approximately thirty minutes prior to calling the Springdale Police Department.

As I arrived on scene, I made contact with Teed in the parking lot. While speaking with Teed, he advised that several of the juveniles were acting very aggressive inside of the facility. I then advised for them to escort myself and Officer French #367 into the facility to make contact with the victim of the assault. While inside of the facility, I made contact with Jaibriel Burke (██████████) who advised that a juvenile had punched him the day prior on 09/28/2024, causing him physical injury. While speaking with Burke, I observed that he had a laceration on his face. Upon asking him how he got this laceration, he advised that a juvenile who was later identified as (██████████) had punched him. He further advised that during the incident, (██████████) had pulled his beard to the point that it tore hair off of his face and scratched his side. I then observed a scratch mark on his side. Due to his visible injuries, I asked him if he wanted to press charges, to which he advised that he did. I began taking photos of Burke's injuries and uploaded them to the Springdale Police Department's Axon Photo Library. I then began speaking with (██████████) who was in an enclosed area of the facility. Upon pulling her out of the enclosed area, she advised that she did not do anything wrong. I explained to her that several people had stated that this incident happened, and that there were physical injuries on Burke. While speaking with (██████████) another incident started to unfold in a separate enclosed area of the facility, where another staff member, who I identified as Teed, had gotten assaulted. While Teed was walking out of the enclosed area of the facility, I observed that the shirt that he was wearing prior had been torn and ripped. Due to this, I advised (██████████) to return to the enclosed area where she was originally at and I entered a separate enclosed portion of the facility to assist Officer French and Officer Dickerson #415.

Upon entering the enclosed area of the facility, I observed a [REDACTED] juvenile that I later identified as [REDACTED] detained and in handcuffs. With the assistance of Officer French, I helped [REDACTED] stand up and escorted her out of the enclosed portion of the facility. While escorting her out, [REDACTED] went limp and did not assist herself with walking. Once Officer French and I escorted her out, myself and the other officers attempted to get [REDACTED] to calm down. Once [REDACTED] had calmed down, I made contact with Teed who advised that he wanted to press charges against [REDACTED].

I then made contact with Burke in the meeting area of the facility. Burke advised that he would complete a witness statement form regarding the incident that had occurred with [REDACTED]. While speaking with Burke, he also provided video surveillance footage of the incident. In this footage, I observed [REDACTED] throw several punches at Burke, causing him physical injury. I then returned to my patrol vehicle to retrieve witness statement forms and Burke and another staff member began completing the witness statement forms. While they were completing these written statement forms, I returned to Teed and asked him what had happened. Teed advised that several juveniles were damaging property in a separate enclosed area of the facility, and in an attempt to de-escalate the situation, [REDACTED] had grabbed onto him from behind and hit him in the face. I observed that he had physical redness and bruising on his face, along with the shirt that was ripped. At this point, Teed had changed shirts so I advised him to retrieve the shirt that he was originally wearing. Once he had retrieved the shirt, I began taking photos of his injury along with the ripped shirt. I then had Teed complete a written statement regarding the incident. The photos have been uploaded to the Springdale Axon Photo Library.

While the victims were completing written statements, Officer French contacted the Washington County Juvenile Intake Department and advised them of the incident. While speaking with Juvenile Intake Officers, they advised that they would be detaining both of the juveniles and requested that officers transport them to the Washington County Juvenile Detention Center. I then advised Officer Dickerson of this, who was still speaking with [REDACTED]. Once Officer French completed his phone call with the Juvenile Intake Officer, we escorted [REDACTED] to a quiet portion of the facility. Officer Dickerson then placed [REDACTED] under arrest for Battery - 3rd Degree. Once Officer Dickerson arrested [REDACTED] he walked her to his patrol vehicle and began transporting her to the Washington County Juvenile Detention Center. Officer French and I then made contact with [REDACTED] and Officer French placed her under arrest for Battery - 3rd Degree. Officer French then walked her to his patrol vehicle and began transporting her to the Washington County Juvenile Detention Center. The Juvenile Intake Officer advised Officer French that [REDACTED] had a court date of 09/30/2024 at 0800 hours and [REDACTED] had a court date of 09/30/2024 at 0830 hours, both at 855 Clydesdale Dr. I collected the written statements and returned to the Springdale Police Department to begin on a juvenile preliminary report form.

The juvenile then began to thrash her entire body and writhe on the ground attempting to wrest free her hands from officer's control. Myself and Officer L. French #367 then placed the juvenile's hands on the small of her back and placed her in handcuffs. Due to the juvenile continually writhing and ignoring warning, I was unable to ensure the fit of the handcuffs but they were double locked. The juvenile was then removed from the containment room where she began to kick at any individual nearby forcing me to catch her legs and restrain them until she ceased lashing out. After everyone stepped away from the juvenile, she was able to calm down a little and I stayed with her and attempted to figure out what had occurred. The juvenile eventually identified herself as [REDACTED] did not provide me with any further information about what had occurred, only stating the male staff member had made her angry after restraining her friend and she got mad. When asked about the incident further [REDACTED] began to change the subject. While sitting and talking with me [REDACTED] began to struggle against her cuffs and even after being warned several times, she was only going to cause abrasions to her skin, [REDACTED] wrested her right hand from the handcuffs. I finished taking the handcuffs off and advised her they could stay off if she controlled her violent outbursts as we were in a controlled room and I did not want to risk injury of attempting to slip out of handcuffs for a second time. [REDACTED] required no medical treatment for the slight redness around her wrists.

Officer J. Moore #397 then confirmed there were charges for Battery 3rd and JDC had made the decision to detain [REDACTED] in light of the situation. I then explained the situation to [REDACTED] and placed her in handcuffs again, this time [REDACTED] was more cooperative and the handcuffs were placed on in a manner where I was able to check the fit and ensure they were double locked. For more information concerning the probable cause and victim please refer to Officer J. Moore's #397 narrative.

[REDACTED] was then transported back to Washington County Juvenile Detention Center and handed over into the intake officer's custody.
