See IR Nursing to see assessment. Patient taken to ER to rule out concussion. Nursing Assessment 10/3/24 Time 6:50 PM : Pt came to nurses station stating that he had hit head on dresser by accident when he went to stand. Upon assessment, pt has superficial laceration about 1.5cm in length to posterior L side of head, close to midline. Serosanguineous fluid present. Blood able to clot appropriately after pressure applied to area. TAO applied. Pt c/o dizziness, h/a @ 4/10, light sensitivity. Pt denies n/v, gait steady. Full ROM in all extremities. Eyes PERRLA. Pt alert and oriented to self/situation. Vitals as follows: BP 124/79 HR 91, temp 97.6, rest even/unlabored. Pt given ibu x2 per MAR. After thirty minutes, pt c/o worsening h/a @ 6/10, increased dizziness/light sensitivity and slight nausea w/o vomiting. Talked to provider. Per provider, pt needs to have concussion r/o. Pt taken to ER at about 2050. Attempted to notify [REDACTED] guardian, 3 times prior to leaving voicemail. 10/3/24 @ 9:31 PM, 9:35 PM and 9:42 PM Attempted to call guardian x3. Voicemail left w/o identifying information, nurse cell number left in voicemail Psychiatrist notified 10/3/24 6:52 PM On Call Therapist, Jori Burns, notified 10/3/24 8:18 PM Unit Manager on call, Beauty Moore notified 10/3/24 @ 8:17 PM
