Report Description: [REDACTED], who is an [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] reported to her therapist that [REDACTED] (staff) hit her in the mouth. After reviewing camera footage, [REDACTED] was going for the staff clipboard that was left on the couch in the dayroom. Staff ran over to the couch attempting to beat [REDACTED] to the paperwork. [REDACTED] grabbed the clipboard before [REDACTED] could get the paperwork. There were books and other items on the ottoman that [REDACTED] tried to grab one of the items [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] tried to get prevent her from getting the item. [REDACTED] pulled her away from the item while [REDACTED] was swiping the item from the couch. [REDACTED] is on her knees due to crawling to the ottoman on the floor. While they are preventing her from getting the item, some type of way she gets hit in the mouth. [REDACTED] did not intentionally hit her in the mouth like she reported. I only saw them going in for the item while resulted in her lip bleeding. They took her to the nurse immediately. The therapist [REDACTED] The report [REDACTED]

Narrative:

Facility visited in response to self-report incident that client [REDACTED] was hit in the mouth during an incident with staff. Camera footage reviewed of incident which occurred in the dayroom 10/8/24. Staff/client ratio 5:18. [REDACTED] is sitting on the floor and heard audibly arguing with staff. [REDACTED] begins to scoot on the floor towards another peer, at which time staff [REDACTED] puts his foot against [REDACTED] and slides her in the opposite direction with his foot seemingly to prevent her from reaching other client. This action was not in the form of a kick nor seemed to result in physical pain to [REDACTED]. Facility 109.1g for unprofessional behavior for scooting client across floor with his foot.

[REDACTED] continues to argue with staff, eventually lunging towards a counter seemingly to grab an object. Two staff, [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] both lunge towards [REDACTED] as to prevent her from retrieving item. After this [REDACTED] grabs her mouth area and indicates she is in pain. Per Sherika Williams of UMCH, client's lip was bleeding, and she was attended to by the nurse. At no time during video review can either staff be definitively seen punching or making contact with [REDACTED] facial area during this incident. Both staff have been counseled regarding this incident. [REDACTED] will be counseled on not scooting clients across floor with his foot. Both staff will be retrained on Phase 2, Tantrum Management.
