She stated the activity occurred two nights in a row shortly after lights out and that she ?sucked [REDACTED] titties,? and they ?touched each other?s private parts?. Peers separated immediately upon notification; [REDACTED] was permanently moved to another unit. Peer restriction implemented. Sexual acting out precautions ? LOS WA applied. Opened investigation (ongoing)

Interim Action Narrative: Residents were separated and are no longer on the same unit.
