

was observed to have a bigger than a quarter size lump on his head behind his left ear that he told his family was from pushing him down and his head hitting the concrete floor when the family asked why this happened stated he was being put in a hold but that she hurt him and then twisted his arm behind his back. The family also reported that the staff at the facility told to not be talking about what had occurred the previous day (Friday the 6th) when the family asked him that's when he stated he was pushed and the discovered the knot on his head.
