[REDACTED] and private placement was upset after visitation with her mom. She refused to follow any prompts or instructions. [REDACTED] attacked staff by grabbing their badge and choking the staff. She kicked staff when staff was attempting to intervene to prevent client from self-harming. [REDACTED] transitioned to unit and continue to punch the walls, bang her head on doors and bite herself. Client was assessed by the nurse finding bruising to her right knuckles due to punching the wall. An x-ray was ordered on 12/16/2024 due to client complaining of pain in her right hand and completed on 12/16/24 finding no fractures, normal appearance of the joint spaces and growth plates.

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**Licensing Narrative:** 12/18/2024 Licensing Specialist Horton inquired of the facility why was this incident not reported on 12/16/2024? Please provide the nurse's note. Was the resident placed on any safety precautions? Facility reported to Licensing on 12/15 during the nurse assessment there were no swelling, bruises or signs that indicated an injury. [REDACTED] complained of pain on 12/16, the x-ray was ordered by the doctor on 12/16 and completed on 12/16. Per Licensing policy The agency shall notify the Licensing Unit by the

next business day of serious injuries requiring emergency medical treatment, agency vehicle accidents, arrests, elopements, suicide attempts, or deaths and maintain documentation of the incident and notification. The facility reported it completed the ELS on 12/17, unless something has changed on the timeframe to report, we are still in compliance. Facility reported to Licensing that the resident was currently on suicide precautions, assault precautions no sharps, spork watch and line of sight 24/7 precautions. The facility reported to Licensing that the resident was ordered to continue these precautions until behavior improves.
