Client was on LOS bathroom protocol and staff was present outside the door with the door ajar. Staff immediately entered the bathroom and removed the clothing item that client was attempting to use. Client was assessed by nurse, who noted a red mark on client's cheek and neck. Following this incident, 1:1 ratio was ordered, and client was referred to acute care. At this time, she has not been accepted for acute care and remains at Centers. The client is an out-of-state placement from at The Centers and the guardian but has been notified. **Interim Action Narrative:** Maltreatment Narrative:
