Narrative:

The Program Manager and Licensing Specialist conducted a walkthrough of the new Piney Ridge Treatment Center/Yellow Rock campus located at 2601 Habberton Rd. Springdale, AR.

914.6-Emergency escape diagrams were posted in all areas used by children.

911.3-The facility reports that they have already had a fire inspection and are waiting on the final report. Licensing requested a copy of that report once it has been received by the facility.

911.4The facility reports that the health inspection is scheduled for this Wednesday 1/8/2025. Licensing requested a copy of that report once it has been received by the facility.

The facility reports that they would like to move the residents as soon as possible and believe that they can move all the residents, their belongings, beds, mattresses, and bedding to the new facility within one to two days.

Construction crews were still on site working on the building. Construction materials to include tools and materials were located throughout the building. Areas still being finished were seen with exposed wires waiting to be secured into place, missing ceiling tile in the library, areas with missing floor trim, and TVs in boxes waiting to be wired in and secured in their protective casings to the walls. The facility reports that the remaining finishing touches should be completed within the next week and the facility will be ready for resident occupancy. Licensing informed the facility that a final walkthrough of the building will have to be done by the specialist to ensure all remaining items are completed prior to the residents occupying the building.

***** Pursuant to A.C.A. § 9-24-406(e)(3-4): If you believe that the Department's notice of noncompliance is in error, you may ask for reconsideration.
