## Primary Narrative By Justin Paradise, 01/27/25 15:32

### Battery

On 01/27/25 at approximately 1339 hours I, Deputy Paradise, was dispatched to 20400 Colonel Glenn Rd for Battery.

I made contact with Kimberly Cox the victims mother. Kimberly stated that her daughter Caelin Cox was assaulted on 01/19/25 & on 01/25/25. Kimberly stated that Caelin was attacked on the 01/19/25 unprovoked by ..... Kimberly stated that Caelin was attacked again unprovoked on 01/25/25 by ..... Caelin was taken by staff on 01/25/25 to Arkansas Children's Hospital to treat her injuries.

Kimberly stated she wanted to pursue charges for both incidents that had occurred. Kimberly was provided with the incident number and advised of the warrant process.

I was able to obtain video footage of both incidents along with the staff members report that was completed. All of the items were submitted into property as evidence. While attempting to upload evidence into the property section item 001 and 002 failed to load properly resulting in the evidence to start with item 003.

The staff member that had completed the reports were not on scene to obtain statements as to what they had observed.
