Primary Narrative By Lance Parker, 01/29/25 01:16

Battery

On 1/28/25 at approximately 2305 hours I, Deputy L. Parker, responded to the Chestnut House at the youth services home located at 20400 Colonel Glenn Road in reference to a disturbance. Upon arrival I made contact with the complainant, Dejuan Williams, who is a Qualified Behavioral Health Provider (QBHP) for the youth home. Williams advised that just prior to our arrival he was involved in an altercation with a resident minor,

Williams advised that _____ got very angry with him this evening when he came into _____ room. He advised that he was attempting to take two water bottles away from _____ after _____ grabbed them and took a fighting stance against Williams. Williams advised that when he attempted to take the bottles _____ struck him in the back of his head with a closed fist and then grabbed a handful of his hair and refused to let go; Williams believed that he may have had some hair pulled out but was unable to locate his hair on the floor at this time. There was a light spot on his head in the area he pointed to where the hair was grabbed. Williams advised that he and several other workers at the youth home had to pry _____ fingers/hand open in order to get him to release his hair. Williams refused medical attention at this time but advised he wishes to pursue charges against _____.

I then made contact with _____ who advised a similar story. _____ stated that _____ was angry at Williams for trying to take things from _____ room and _____ grabbed his hair. _____ advised that _____ left hand was sore from where staff had to force _____ hand open to get _____ to release William's hair. There was visible redness on _____ left hand. I spoke with another QBHP that was present during the incident and witnessed the altercation, Diana Coleman. Coleman advised a similar recount as Williams in that she saw _____ take an aggressive stance holding two hard plastic water bottles filled with water like _____ was about to use them against Williams. Coleman then observed as Williams took the water bottles away from _____ and then _____ struck Williams in the back of the head and grabbed his hair. She advised that it took several staff members prying _____ hand open before _____ finally released William's hair.

I was informed by the staff that MEMS was already on the way to the scene to transport _____ to Rivendell. I contacted the Juvenile Intake Officer, Elizabeth Mahan, and apprised her of the situation; I advised her that I am looking to charge _____ with Battery 2nd due to _____ causing injury to a professional worker for Youth Services. Mrs. Mahan advised to issue a court date to _____ February 27, 2025 at 1000 hours. I completed an ADR for _____.

Battery 2nd and provided _____ with _____ copy containing said court date. A copy of the ADR and photographs were attached to this report to be used as evidence. The original ADR was submitted to records for dissemination to the proper channels.

MEMS 625 arrived on scene. I apprised them of the situation and requested they conduct an assessment on _____ mental well-being due to the caller advising to dispatch that _____ was feeling "homicidal" toward staff. I also requested they check _____ for injuries following the altercation. _____ was cleared by MEMS to be transported to Rivendell; _____ was loaded onto the ambulance and transported without further incident. I provided the staff at the Chestnut House with _____ report number and advised them to contact the Sheriff's Office if they have any further questions. Staff advised there are cameras in the building, however, the one nearest to _____ room would likely be unable to see much of the incident. They advised me that they could not access cameras at this time, but may be able to provide camera footage at a later date.

I was advised by staff that _____ with Nevada County DHS. Her information and phone number are attached to this report as requested by Mrs. Mahan so that she can be made aware of this situation.
