Primary Narrative By Lance Parker, 01/29/25 01:16

On 1/28/25 at approximately 2305 hours I, Deputy L. Parker, responded to the Chestnut House at the youth services home located at 20400 Colonel Glenn Road in reference to a disturbance. Upon arrival I made contact with the complainant, Dejuan Williams, who is a Qualified Behavioral Health Provider (QBHP) for the youth home. Williams advised that just prior to our arrival he was involved in an altercation with a resident minor,

Williams advised that got very angry with him this evening when he came into room. He advised that he grabbed them and took a fighting stance was attempting to take two water bottles away from after against Williams. Williams advised that when he attempted to take the bottles struck him in the back of his head with a closed fist and then grabbed a handful of his hair and refused to let go; Williams believed that he may have had some hair pulled out but was unable to locate his hair on the floor at this time. There was a light spot on his head in the area he pointed to where the hair was grabbed. Williams advised that he and several other workers at the youth fingers/hand open in order to get him to release his hair. Williams refused medical attention at this time but advised he wishes to pursue charges against I then made contact with who advised a similar story. stated that was angry at Williams for trying to take things from __room and __grabbed his hair. __advised that __left hand was sore from where staff had to force to release William's hair. There was visible redness on left hand. I spoke with hand open to get another QBHP that was present during the incident and witnessed the altercation, Diana Coleman. Coleman advised a similar recount as Williams in that she saw take an aggressive stance holding two hard plastic water bottles filled with water like was about to use them against Williams. Coleman then observed as Williams took the water and then ... struck Williams in the back of the head and grabbed his hair. She advised bottles away from that it took several staff members prying hand open before finally released William's hair. I was informed by the staff that MEMS was already on the way to the scene to transport to Rivendell. I

MEMS 625 arrived on scene. I apprised them of the situation and requested they conduct an assessment on mental well-being due to the caller advising to dispatch that was feeling "homicidal" toward staff. I also requested they check for injuries following the altercation. was cleared by MEMS to be transported to Rivendell; was loaded onto the ambulance and transported without further incident. I provided the staff at the Chestnut House with report number and advised them to contact the Sheriff's Office if they have any further questions. Staff advised there are cameras in the building, however, the one nearest to room would likely be unable to see much of the incident. They advised me that they could not access cameras at this time, but may be able to provide camera footage at a later date.

I was advised by staff that with Nevada County DHS. Her information and phone number are attached to this report as requested by Mrs. Mahan so that she can be made aware of this situation.
