was allowed in the bathroom on for about 10 mins. She
responded when the first staff knocked on the door, the second time she did the resident did
not respond. The staff informed the nurse and the nurse quickly opened the bathroom and
observed the resident was on the floor in the shower with her back up against the wall with
what appeared to be a pair of leggings/pajama pants tied around her neck. Resident face
appeared slightly purple with her eyes closed. The nurse quickly unraveled the
leggings/pajama pants from resident's neck using her hands. Once the item was taken from
around her neck the nurse watch resident face return back to her normal skin tone and
watch her respiration's. The nurse and 2nd staff help resident up off the floor and the nurse
did a risk assessment to which she scored high. The nurse process with resident and
resident explain that she was done because her peers didn't want to talk to her because she
has went back on having self harm behaviors. Resident stated 10/10 emotional pain and
resident had an unopened red mark around her neck that was slowly fading away. Once the
nurse return resident back to the day room the nurse told resident's therapist what happen
and got an order from APRN at 0841 to have the door crack open till she is off precaution
along with being RTU X 24 hours. We made referrals to placements per APRN order
at 1022 am. She was accepted on 3/18/25 to and went there mid
morning.
