[REDACTED] Today on 03/31/2025 @ 1815 resident was running around outside playing doge ball. When resident went to sit down on the bench her right knee popped out of place leaving resident unable to bare weight on her right leg. A nurse was called to assess resident. Resident was wearing long skinny jeans that were too difficult to lift up to see the right knee, but it was evident that resident's right knee cap was not aligned with her right knee veering off towards the right side of her knee. Nurse ask resident if she could straighten her leg out to which resident stated "no". Resident was ask if this has ever happen before resident responded "no". Even though resident didn't appear to be in much pain resident pain was an 8 out of 10. Resident was given [REDACTED] and an Ice pack for her right knee. [REDACTED], APRN was called at 1825 where the nurse was given an verbal order to send resident out to [REDACTED]. The nurse called transport who then took a female staff to take resident to [REDACTED] @ 1900. Will contact DON and legal guardian via email. Will send update as soon as resident returns from [REDACTED]. Upon return resident is on crutches and has a knee brace. She will follow-up with [REDACTED] next week.
