***Body Camera Activated

On April 8, 2025 at approximately 1815 hours, I (PFC French 367) along with other officers responded code three to a physical fight at 2466 South 48th Street. The caller is a staff member for Perimeter of the Ozarks and stated two to three girls are attacking the staff members.

Upon arrival, I made contact with one of the staff members who was attacked. I identified the victim as Dezmon Stone Adult [REDACTED]. Dezmon stated several girls in the facility started fighting with each other and when he intervenes, he was punched in the face twice and bitten on his arm by a [REDACTED]

Dezmon stated he attempted to restrain [REDACTED] but she was able to get away from him. Dezmon stated she reached back and punched him once in the upper lip causing it to bleed and once on the left side of his face. I observed Dezmon had a small cut on the inside of his top lip. I also observed he had redness and swelling on the side of his left eyebrow. Dezmon went on to say he was finally able to restrain [REDACTED] on the ground. While struggling to get control of [REDACTED] Dezmon stated she was able to get loose again and turned her body and bite him on his left arm. I observed Dezmon had teeth marks on the inside of his left arm, just below his elbow. Dezmon is an employee of Perimeter of the Ozarks and he works as a mental health technician.

I developed probable cause for Battery 2nd degree. I contacted [REDACTED] mother; [REDACTED]. I requested she meet me at the location. I contacted Ashley bush from Washington county JDC and provided my probable cause. Ashley requested I transport [REDACTED] to JDC to be detained. Ashley provided me with a Court date of April 10th 2025 at 0810 hours. I provided the court details to [REDACTED] and she stated she understood.

I transported [REDACTED] to the Springdale juvenile holding cell. A felony prelim was done and approved. I transported [REDACTED] to Washington County JDC where she was released to the custody of the jailers. End narrative. 367.

On 4/8/2025 at approximately 5:42pm dispatch advised that there were 2 or 3 juveniles that were attacking staff at the perimeter of the Ozarks located at 2466 S 48th st B. I checked en route at which point dispatch advised that the altercation is still physical so I provided an upgraded response. I arrived on scene at 6:01pm and was allowed entry into the facility by staff. Once I entered I witnessed several staff members surrounding the nurses station and several other staff members restraining a female behind the desk, I approached the two females and began to speak with them, I addressed one of the females and Officer Springston #386 spoke with the other. The female I spoke with was identified as [REDACTED] advised that she did not attack anyone but was simply fed up with being at the facility and was attempting to commit suicide, I asked her how and she explained that she was going to try and swallow several monopoly pieces.

I spoke with the charge nurse, and informed her of the statements made by [REDACTED] and she advised that the facility would be able to handle it as they had their own protocol and direct access to her medical care providers. It was at this point that I left to let other officers into the building at which point I caught them up on the situation and began to check with other officers to see if any subjects had charges, as I was doing so, we were advised of a fight that had broken out between other residents and staff that was involved. Officers entered the room and began to assist as the residents were still actively being combative. I assisted in separating several individuals and when I noticed officers were placing a female I handcuffs I began to assist them. When I was assisting officers with that female I looked over and saw another female that was then being combative and I went over there to begin to assist. When we had gotten several combative females under control we were then advised of several other fights that had broken out, myself and several other officers attempted to separate the females and then assist with the other fights as they occurred. As more fights continued officers then began to bring females out of the facility into their patrol vehicle as there were no other places to isolate them to prevent more fights from happening.

When I walked a female out to my vehicle who had been combative she was then identified as [REDACTED] [REDACTED] was placed in the back of my vehicle and I stood by with her to maintain supervision be wait further as to her role in the several different altercations. As I stood by I was then advised that [REDACTED] was identified by a staff member as the resident that had attacked him and caused him injury, the staff member was identified as Derek Young([REDACTED]) Young provided officers with a written statement in which he stated that he was attacked by a resident and received several "blows to the head and chest area causing him soreness, I spoke with Young and he confirmed that [REDACTED] is the female that attacked him. [REDACTED] mother was notified of the circumstance and charges of Battery 2nd, she along with the facility agreed the facility would maintain custody of [REDACTED], after contacting Washington County Juvenile detention center she was provided with a court date and released back to the facility, no further at this time.

On Tuesday, April 8, 2025 at approximately 1754 hours I (PFC L. Wagner #419) was dispatched to the Perimeter of the Ozarks Behavioral Facility at 2466 S 48th St B in reference to a Disturbance call. The caller advised dispatch that 2 or 3 juveniles were physically attacking the staff.

Upon my arrival I made contact with several of the facility staff members and several of the suspects at the nurse's station. One suspect, [REDACTED] was sitting behind the nurse's station. I spoke with three staff members, Sabrina McLellan [REDACTED] Keith Bohannon [REDACTED], and Derek, about the actions of [REDACTED]

Sabrina and Keith both explained that [REDACTED] got out of her unit and jumped over the nurse's station into a restricted area. [REDACTED] then sat down because she is aware that the staff cannot restrain her if she is in a seated position. [REDACTED] then began threatening the staff, saying that she was going to hit anyone that tried to intervene. Keith and Sabrina both advised that [REDACTED] threatened to hit them if they tried to restrain her. [REDACTED] began throwing things at staff members and yelling and screaming, causing the other juveniles to act in a similar manner. [REDACTED] then opened a drawer and pulled out a pair of scissors and threatened to cut Keith and other staff members with the scissors. Keith, an RN, and other staff members attempted to retrieve the scissors from [REDACTED] struggled with Keith and the other staff members and in the struggle, [REDACTED] cut Keith several times with the scissors. I observed the lacerations to Keith's hands from the scissors. Keith explained that [REDACTED] then became more escalated and threatened to hit Keith, saying that she was going to "rock my shit" to Keith and raised a fist at him. Keith explained that he believed [REDACTED] would further injure him or herself given her behavior at the time when she raised her fist at him. [REDACTED] was then placed in an isolated room where I stood by with her for the majority of the time.

Due to [REDACTED] actions, her yelling, disregarding instructions from staff, throwing things at staff and threatening them, and physically fighting with them, six other juveniles began to conduct themselves in a



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similar behavior, creating a dangerous situation that resulted in the injury of several other staff members of the facility. Of these six, several were charged with Battery 2nd (Felony) along with other charges.

While myself and others Officers continued to try and deescalate the situation and figure out who was being charged with what, multiple juveniles had to be restrained, either in handcuffs or with hand control, to keep them from hurting themselves, or staff, or Officers.

I contacted the Washington County Juvenile Detention Center and spoke with Intake Officer Ashley Bush. I explained to Ashley that I would have charges for Inciting Riot (Felony), Battery 2nd Degree (Felony), Terroristic Threatening 2nd Degree, and Assault 3rd Degree for [REDACTED] Ashley advised that they would detain [REDACTED] and provided a court date of 4/10/2025 at 0815 hours in Division 8 at 123 N College Ave.

I then transported [REDACTED] to the Springdale Jail where I completed a juvenile prelim and then transported her to JDC where she was turned over to their staff. I have no further information at this time. See other Officer's narratives for further.

I spoke with the charge nurse, and informed her of the statements made by [REDACTED] and she advised that the facility would be able to handle it as they had their own protocol and direct access to her medical care providers. It was at this point that I left to let other officers into the building at which point I caught them up on the situation and began to check with other officers to see if any subjects had charges, as I was doing so, we were advised of a fight that had broken out between other residents and staff that was involved. Officers entered the room and began to assist as the residents were still actively being combative. I assisted in separating several individuals and when I noticed officers were placing a female I handcuffs I began to assist them. When I was assisting officers with that female I looked over and saw another female that was then being combative and I went over there to begin to assist. When we had gotten several combative females under control we were then advised of several other fights that had broken out, myself and several other officers attempted to separate the females and then assist with the other fights as they occurred. As more fights continued officers then began to bring females out of the facility into their patrol vehicle as there were no other places to isolate them to prevent more fights from happening.

When I walked a female out to my vehicle who had been combative she was then identified as [REDACTED] [REDACTED] was placed in the back of my vehicle and I stood by with her to maintain supervision be wait further as to her role in the several different altercations. As I stood by I was then advised that [REDACTED] was identified by a staff member as the resident that had attacked him and caused him injury, the staff member was identified as Derek [REDACTED] Young provided officers with a written statement in which he stated that he was attacked by a resident and received several "blows to the head and chest area causing him soreness, I spoke with Young and he confirmed that [REDACTED] is the female that attacked him. [REDACTED] mother was notified of the circumstance and charges of Battery 2nd, she along with the facility agreed the facility would maintain custody of [REDACTED] after contacting Washington County Juvenile detention center she was provided with a court date and released back to the facility, no further at this time.

On 04/08/2025 at approximately 1742 I was dispatched to 2466 S 48th street Perimeter of the Ozarks for a physical disturbance.

The caller stated that there were 2-3 juveniles that were attacking staff.

Upon arrival the staff had one female detained on ground and the other two females were sitting behind the nursed station.

I placed handcuffs on the female that was being held on the ground, she was later identified as [REDACTED] [REDACTED] became mostly compliant after she was placed under arrest.

Other Officers arrived on scene to assist. As we were speaking with staff another fight broke out in one of the living quarters. Staff and other officers ran in to break up the fight. One staff member was thrown into a wall and punched in the face.

More fights broke out in other pods as well as classrooms. several female juveniles were placed under arrest for violent crimes.

As I was assisting staff in a classroom a juvenile female who was later identified as [REDACTED] [REDACTED] was throwing desks and attempting to break classroom property. [REDACTED] was also screaming profanities and threatening staff members.

I placed [REDACTED] into handcuffs and sat her in the hallway away from everyone.

[REDACTED] was screaming and cursing at me, kicking me and attempted to bite me. [REDACTED] was screaming threats at a staff member named Sabrina McLellan [REDACTED] told Sabrina that she was going to "beat her ass" once she was released.

I placed [REDACTED] into the back of my patrol car, [REDACTED] continued to yell and curse, she attempted to kick my back
