Licensing inquired about door damage. 4/24/2024, facility provided licensing with a picture of the door damage. Licensing requsted a picture once door was replaced. Per facility, "The magnetic lock held but door was bent at bottom. Could lock with key if someone pushed on it from outside. The back door was damaged but held. The front door was not damaged but did not hold. Do not believe that the resident received a citation from the police. Supposedly will have a new door installed tomorrow." 4/30/2025, followed up with facility on the replacing the door. Facility reported it will 3 to 4 weeks due to the door being custom made.
