[REDACTED] Events Leading: Client jumped on one of his peers and hit a nurse with an egg.  
Client thought he was being taken to jail by the Sheriff's department and decided to bust  
out of the door at [REDACTED]. Client continued to run but was caught by law  
enforcement. Client was taken to [REDACTED] for further observations. UM on call,  
CT on call and nurse were notified. Client spent the night at [REDACTED] and  
was transferred to [REDACTED] for an [REDACTED] on 04/21/25. Nursing  
Assessment date/time: 04/20/25 9:40pm: Patient observed being walked to sheriff vehicle  
under his own strength by two deputies. Guardian was notified on 04/20/25 at 9:07pm,

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Licensing Narrative: 4/21/2025, facility informed licensing of this provider reported incident via email. 4/22/2025, Licensing reviewed provider reported incident for licensing concerns. The facility provided documentation for this provider reported incident. Documentation reviewed and uploaded. Licensing inquired about door damage. 4/24/2024, facility provided licensing with a picture of the door damage. Licensing requested a picture once door was replaced. Per facility, "The magnetic lock held but door was bent at bottom. Could lock with key if someone pushed on it from outside. The back door was damaged but held. The front door was not damaged but did not hold. Do not believe that the resident received a citation from the police. Supposedly will have a new door installed tomorrow." 4/30/2025, followed up with facility on the replacing the door. Facility reported it will 3 to 4 weeks due to the door being custom made.
