Battery 2nd / Fleeing on Foot

On April 20, 2025, at approximately 2046 hours, I, Deputy Escamilla, responded to 20400 Colonel Glenn Rd Little Rock, AR 72210, in reference to a battery that occurred between a juvenile and a staff member at Sturgis House.

Upon arrival, I made contact with Matthew Chrysler, who advised that around 2003 hours, intentionally threw a hard boiled egg at him from across the room and struck him in the hand. Matthew is a Licensed Practical Nurse (LPN) with the Youth Home. Matthew advised the impact left a red mark on his left hand below his index finger however, upon my contact there was no longer a visible redness. Matthew stated that was involved in an altercation earlier during the day with a few of the residents. Matthew advised he wanted to press charges against and that he would try to get video footage of the incident.

I made contact with Juvenile Intake, Lori Carrigan, and advised her of the incident. I provided Lori with the information requested and she advised me of a court date. I completed the A.D.R. and had one of the staff members sign the A.D.R. Matthew completed a witness statement form.

I advised Matthew and staff members that was being charged with Battery 2nd Degree (5-13-202) with a court date of May 12th at 0900 hours. They were provided with the copy of the A.D.R., court date, and report number.

While still on scene the staff members advised that was riling up the residents and kept making remarks toward staff members and myself. A loud banging noise could be heard and the staff members advised that was pushing against the back door trying to get out. ran straight into room, onto bed, and under the covers. I made contact with along with one of the members however, did not acknowledge us in the room.

I observed _____ get up from the bed and make _____ way into the open living room quarters. Once _____ makes _____ way into the open area _____ takes off running in a full sprint past staff members and pops open the front door. Staff members along with myself take off after _____

I advised Dispatch that _____ took off from Sturgis House heading towards the area of Crestview house and provide clothing description. I advised Dispatch that _____ is a _____ wearing black shorts and black jacket.

Deputy Bass and Deputy Knobloch are at Crestview House due to another incident that was happening and step out once I give out my transmission of _____ fleeing. I continue running towards the back end of one of the houses and located Deputy Knobloch with _____ Deputy Knobloch was able to get _____ handcuffed with no complications. Deputy Knobloch and I assisted _____ on standing up and _____ was placed into Deputy Bass's patrol unit.

I made contact with Lori from Juvenile Intake at 2140 hours and advised her of the updated charges for _____. She advised that the new charges would be added to _____ case and the court date would remain the same. I advised the staff members of this information.

Deputy Bass and I stood by while Matthew made arrangements to get _____ sent to an acute treatment facility due to _____ behavior escalating. Matthew confirmed arrangements have been made for _____ Deputy Bass and I transported _____ to Arkansas Children's Hospital and a staff member followed us. _____ was then transferred to the staff member and Arkansas Children's Hospital Security with no complications.

_____ was charged with Battery 2nd Degree (5-13-202) and Fleeing on Foot (5-54-125(c)).

Matthew's witness statement form and photos were entered into property.

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
